1. ON 16 DECEMBER CBW CASE OFFICER TOLD LIMA-1 MOSCOW INSTRUCTIONS HAD ARRIVED. L-1 TRAVELED TO BEIJING ABOUT 10 JANUARY TO LOS ANGELES, DJAKARTA, MANILA FOR TWO MONTHS. SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS TO BE PROVIDED 3 JANUARY. L-1 TO GET TWO THOUSAND U.S. DOLLARS FOR SUPPORT MOTHER AND CHILDREN AND \$350 PER MONTH SALARY FOR TWO MONTHS. CBW TOLD L-1 TO LOOK OVER SITUATION IN DJAKARTA AND MANILA AND REPORT HIS FINDINGS. TOLD TRIP IS SECRET. IF CBW LIKES REPORT L-1 HOURS TO BE PAID APPROXIMATELY \$2,700. CBW TOLD L-1 AFTER THREE AND ONE HALF YEARS ASSOCIATION FINALLY GO TO BE ADVISED NATURE OF IMPORTANCE. INSTRUCTED TO GET VISA AND OTHERS FROM CBW. CBW ASKED IF ANY PREFERENCE FOR LEAVE L-1 EXPLAINED HIS RECENT PAYING COMMUNIST TELLING FRIENDS PEOPLES FIRM WANTS HIM. INVESTIGATE MARKET POTENTIAL FUTURE. L-1 TOLD MAYA APPROPRIATE AGENCIES NOTIFY CBW IF TRIP TAKES LONGER THAN TWO MONTHS. CBW TOLD L-1 WOULD KEEP PERSON IN MANILA.

2. PRESENTING TRIP ESSENTIALS IF CBW CLEARS CBW PLANNING SIGNIFICANT USE APPROX INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION FOR L-1 SINCE EXPENDITURE LARGE FUND (\$7,500) UNUSUAL FOR CBW FOR THIS TYPE OF OP. IN QUEST FOR COVER JOB POSSIBILITIES BECAUSE HUMAN INVOLVEMENT IS MINIMAL.
