At (Ashland), Pennsylvania

On 8 November 1960, (GEORGE YODER) Postmaster, was interviewed on the premises of his residence at 1008 Spruce Street. The informant was advised that mail directed to DANIEL and/or MILDRED C _____ at (Ashland), Pennsylvania, was no longer anticipated. He was asked to take the necessary action to cancel forwarding arrangements in existence. MR. (YODER) indicated that to his knowledge nothing had been received in the above names and that he would personally attend to the cancellation of forwarding instructions which are on file at the Post Office.

At Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

On 9 November 1960, the postal facility, Post Office Box #8055, General Post Office, 30th and Market Streets, held in the names of the SUBJECT'S ostensible parents was closed out. The keys to the box were turned in and no forwarding address was left for the C _____ 's.
