2. The name (<sup>07</sup>GUZMAN) is utilized by subject as an alias, however, his (<sub>31</sub> passport) is (<sub>08</sub> number 19406) furnished by this Agency.

3. Our file has no entries prior to April 1964 when subject was admitted under Special Procedures from Canada.
