To whom it may concern:

My name is [George Roberto Mercida Pestana] Cuban citizen
who arrived to this country last November 4, 1961, through Key West
aboard by boat. My alien number is: [A11-60914].

Corporal [Covaldo Ramirez] who has been fighting for two
years [Castro's communists in the mountains of the Escambray without
any help from anyone, has sent me here with a special mission and a
message of gratitude to the United States for the cooperation in the
struggle against Castro, even though the Escambray anti-communist
fighters haven't received anything but forgetfulness.

For these purposes, only we have been ordered to contact
directly a representative from the C.I.A. in order to deliver my
message from Major [Covaldo Ramirez] to find out if things could be
settled down between the true and genuine Escambray's Army he leads
and C.I.A., not having any kind of Cuban politician relating in
our private meetings, that are no others but Cuban sufferings and
our private necessities to continue or start a real war against the
Red Militia men that are surrounding us right at this very moment
in the Escambray's mountains.

To identify myself, I've brought a letter and some other
documents in which I am authorized to converse and have any kind
of dealings with the C.I.A. in order to get a real quick help, and
a support for our front at the Escambray.

Hoping to hear the sooner possible from you for our cause
and because I must get back to the mountains with all the help I
could get right away.
