COMMENTS:

1. Source does not remember names easily, and some of the names mentioned in this report may be incomplete. While Source was extremely open and co-operative in describing most details of the MRR, he refused to identify the MRR member within Cuban Army Intelligence on the grounds that the information was too sensitive.
2. Regarding information requested in DIR-14969, Source reported that two radio stations are being established, one in Mexico and one in Cuba. The MRR manifesto is still pending and must be read by Source before it circulates in Cuba. The MRR has circulated the following anti-CASTRO materials:
 - (a) The resignation letter of Manuel Francisco ARTILE Buesa;
 - (b) A chapter of ARTILE's book (the chapter is entitled "Unforgettable Meeting")
 - (c) A second letter from ARTILE in reply to accusations made on television by Fidel CASTRO;
 - (d) Two pamphlets, entitled PATIESTA, Father of Communism by Oscar SENEVARIAS, and ANTI-Communist.
3. Regarding Para. 6, Source reported that Frank SPARROW met, on the plane from Havana to Mexico, a member of the British Embassy in Mexico City who invited him, and through him, Source to talk with him at the British Embassy.

1. The main centers of activity of the Movimiento Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MRR, co-ordinated anti-CASERO movement) within Cuba are in the provinces of Havana, Pinar del Rio, Camaguey, and Oriente. The MRR has the following leaders in Cuba:

Carlo RODRIGUEZ, who travels throughout Cuba pretending that he is organizing help for Haiti

- national Territorial co-ordinator

Cuillín ROSS

- general co-ordinator

Manuel VIGIL, an engineer

- treasurer

Rafael UVAS Vazquez

- director of propaganda

Julio O. DIAZ Alonso, president of the Rice Producers' Association

- chief of Oriente Province

Rogelio GUTIÉRREZ Corzo, an engineer

- chief of Havana Province

Captain Jorge SOTUS

- chief military co-ordinator

Hector DIAZ

- chief of action

Fernando ROCHA (PNU)

- secretary of university affairs

Julio MARTINEZ Vargas

- chief, Municipality of Havana

2. MRR contacts with the Catholic Church in Cuba include Bishop of Santiago de Cuba; Msgr. Alvarez, Vicar of MAC, Bishop of Havana; the Archdiocese of Miami; Ignatius, Carmelites, Capuchins, Marists, and the Franciscans.

The MGR is also in touch with members of the Revolutionary Government of Cuba, including: a member of Cuban Army Intelligence (d-a), the ex-CIA Martiniano Munoz (by alias), former Minister of Public Education; former head of the 26th of July Movement in Havana when it was a clandestine organization, also are in touch with the MGR. Military leaders of the Revolutionary Government in Oriente, Santa Clara, and Pinar del Rio provinces are being contacted by the MGR, and it is making special efforts to re-erect Major JESÚS, chief of police in Oriente Province.] 06,08

3. In addition to the integrated groups of the MGR, both inside and outside of Cuba, the MGR has relations and is endeavoring to obtain closer alliances, co-ordination, or cooperation with the following: Manuel Antonio VÁZQUEZ and his followers within the Partido Auténtico Abstencionista; leaders of the "MGR" group; and the "27th" of March group of Camaguey province. The organization is also in touch with some former BATISTA officers, such as Major AGUERA and Manuel VILLARIA Martínez, and with Justo CALVO Hernández.] 06

4. The MGR needs: 1) a base where it can give military training to young people who lack military experience; 2) instructors to give the military training; and 3) equipment, including armaments and planes. Many Cubans, both in Cuba and abroad, have offered financial assistance to the MGR; however, the money will not be forthcoming until a base is established in Cuba from which the MGR can start working.

5. José CANTÚ, Cuban now in Mexico, has been reported to the MGR as an informer for File # CANTÚ info. 5-6540

6. Frank MELIENDO, one of the ADU members who participated in the Havana plot, laying episode directed against Américo THOMAS, is now in Mexico City. He said that many of those who participated in the event are in hiding and will have to leave Cuba. MELIENDO was discharged from his job in a bank for his part in the incident.

2. VÁZQUEZ has great possibilities of becoming the candidate for president of the U.S.

3. This group is called either the "MGR" or "MGR".

4. The MGR excludes all well-known military figures, both civilian and military men; however, it has certain relatives of the ex-president and military associated with the ADU in their efforts to keep them in minor roles within the MGR.
