<sup>03</sup> Per telephone conversation of 18 January between Mr. Lally of your office and Miss Zerance of WH/1 we wish to again request an amendment to LICOOKY-1's Operational Approval to include her utilization as an access agent against a Soviet Press Attache and Soviet Information Bulletin representative. <sup>08</sup>  
This request for amendment was previously approved on 26 June 1964 but was never implemented since the Soviet target's visit to Mexico City never materialized. On 13 January we were notified that the Soviet will now be coming to Mexico City and that the Station would once again want to utilize LICOOKY-1 in the access agent capacity.
