The letterhead memorandum is marked "Secret" inasmuch as the original information furnished (by CIA in this matter) was so classified.

The indices of the NYO contain no information identifiable with WILLIAM STEINSMITH, his father, DAVID, or mother, DOTTIE.

Inasmuch as the subject is reportedly remaining in Copenhagen, the NYO does not contemplate any further investigation in this matter at this time.
