Reference is made to your request of February 6, 1961, via liaison channels, in which you requested subject be interviewed as to whether he had been in contact in Cuba on January 18, 1961, with Eduardo Andres Ojeda (Camarasa) and Orlando Barbero Sans Mateu. (S) (U)

This matter was casually brought up during our interview with the subject on February 16, 1961, in such a manner as not to arouse any suspicion on his part. Subject stated he was not acquainted with any of these individuals, although it was possible that he may have met them in Cuba. Subject stated he spent the two weeks prior to his flight from Cuba on January 20, 1961, in Havana preparing for his departure. He indicated that his only contacts during that period were with the group of close aides who accompanied him to the United States. (S) (U)

NOTE: Subject is prominent Batista opponent and Castro supporter who defected. San Antonio is interviewing him. CIA asked us to interview him concerning any contact he may have had with the two above-mentioned individuals. These two individuals were [connected with a CIA operation] and were turned in in Cuba. CIA speculated subject may have turned them in. (S) (U)
