"I can still be of use to you, even from here, if you think it worthwhile. The Committee could shut down within a few days without any serious difficulties, especially now that Lee has learned he isn't going to get any money from our friends in the Caribbean. Or - as I said before, it could be preserved and made harmless for use as a cover for an information-gathering agency." (S)

"If I am no longer here, Tony will know where to reach me." (S)
