- Don't recall that Rep. City st. developed any info that LHO was in contact with anyone else at Colon Edillery. Then Dogue & Duran
- ? re FBI doc. on Teresa Proenza's brothers  
Comments - "Don't strike any bells." Don't recall any such document.
- Somewhere it's coming back that Proenza was a lesbian - don't recall if that was fact or disinformation.
- It would have been problematic for an agent in her city to be seen out of Stykane station without my knowledge - but I would have been nervous
