Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is in reference to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for information regarding Samuel Bodman. The FBI referred documents to the Department of Defense, Freedom of Information Division (#20-F-0146), which was received in their office on October 24, 2019. The DoD forwarded these documents to our office on May 7, 2020 for our review and direct response to you. Your request was received in our office on May 8, 2020.

We reviewed the enclosed documents pursuant to the FOIA. We have deleted information that is exempt from disclosure pursuant to title 5, United States Code, sections 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C). These sections exempt information that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy.

We also withheld information pursuant to exemption (b)(7)(E), protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such a disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.

You have the right to appeal this response by submitting a written request to the: Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency; ATTN: Office of General Counsel; 27130 Telegraph Road; Quantico, VA 22134. Clearly mark the outside of the envelope and your written appeal letter: "Privacy/FOIA Appeal". Your appeal must be received by DCSA within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of this letter to be considered timely. Your written appeal letter should include the reasons why the requested information should be released and why this action may be in error. Include with your appeal letter a copy of your original request and this response letter. Please reference tracking number DCSA-B 2020-08074.

You may seek dispute resolution services from the DCSA FOIA Public Liaison or the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS). 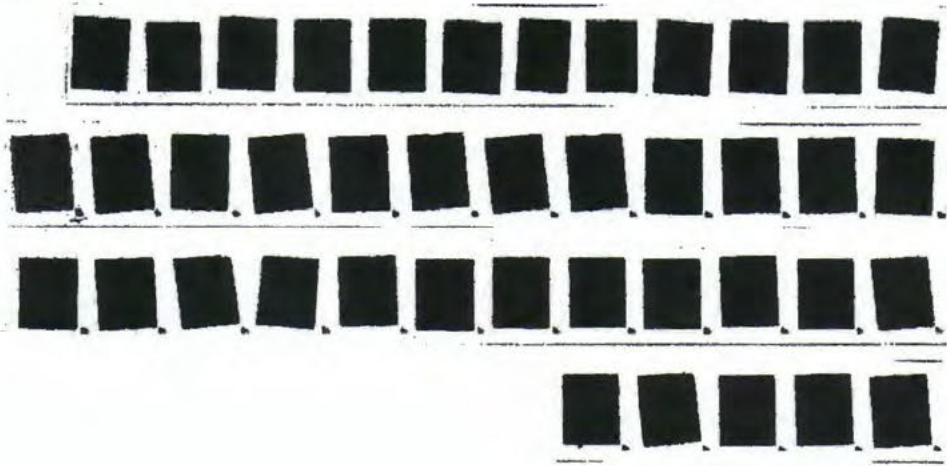

12. On 16 Mar 87, an interview of Subject was conducted as part of an Interview Oriented Background Investigation. The interview consisted of an indepth review of Subject's security questionnaire and personnel security criteria and required 35 minutes to complete.

Subject advised that in addition to his listed foreign travel in about Feb 78, he traveled to London, England and Deuseldorff, W. Germany on FI business and during this trip, he spent a weekend sightseeing in Paris, France. He also travelled to Belgium in either 1978 or 79 for one week, again on FI business. He did not list these trips as he was instructed to only list travel that

occurred within the most recent five year period. He also informed that his vacation in Mexico was in Jan 84, not Jan 83, and his business trip to the Republic of South Africa was in Feb 84, not Feb 85. These were typographical errors. Subsequent to completion of his PSQ, he spent a long weekend sightseeing in Montreal, Canada with his wife in Jan 87, and from 26 Feb to 01 Mar 87, he and his wife vacationed to Harbour Island, The Bahamas. Subject denied any unusual incidents or irresponsible activity during any travel outside the US.

Subject commented favorably concerning family, educational and employment history. Subject denied any abuse of alcohol or drugs, any adverse involvement with law enforcement agencies, and any mental or emotional problems or treatment. Subject professed honesty, financial responsibility, trustworthiness and loyalty to the US. Subject disclaimed any beliefs, actions or affiliations which would indicate a desire to deny others their civil rights or to overthrow the US Government through unconstitutional means, nor knowledge of any such activity on the part of family or associates. Subject provided no information which would indicate poor judgement, unreliability or susceptibility to coercive pressure.

Subject denied any personal knowledge of the unauthorized disclosure of classified information, the illegal transfer of U.S. technology, or involvement with any hostile intelligence activity directed against the U.S.

Subject was completely cooperative and forthright during the interview and expressed no reservations about holding a security clearance.

Less than 10% of Subject's time is devoted to RFI duties and he receives no compensation from the above foreign entities. Subject's compensation for RFI duties is included in his salary from CC. Subject does not have any personal financial investment/ownership in the above mentioned foreign entities.

CPHKL produces plastic concentrates and NU and CCI both produce carbon black, all of which are used in commercial applications. No military hardware is produced by the foreign entities. CPHKL does sell products to companies in the Peoples Republic of China (PRC) and NU has previously sold carbon black to Cuba. Subject has no direct involvement in the marketing or sales of the above products into PRC or Cuba.

Subject does not believe a current or potential conflict of interest situation exists between his RFI status and holding a US security clearance. CC policy has a built in procedure to effectively cope with any potential conflict of interest situation.

Subject has not exchanged any confidential CC scientific or technical information to anyone in a communist or formerly Soviet Union country. Subject denied any suspicious incidents or contacts with anyone, foreign or domestic, inquiring as to his security clearance or classified material. Subject acknowledged he fully understood his obligation to contact appropriate US Government officials, FBI, etc if any suspicious incidents occur.

Subject provided full identities of PRC government officials he met in Beijing and Shanghai, China during JUL 92. Subject also provided full identities of Russian citizens who visited him in Boston, MA during JUN 92. Subject provided a complete list of foreign business/personal travel since JAN 88.

Subject agreed to provide a written, signed, sworn statement detailing his RFI status, foreign connections and foreign travel. This interview was terminated to allow for statement preparation.

Subject responded with only favorable information regarding questions posed about his conduct (including use of alcohol and drugs), employment, school attendance, activities, associates, and personal finances. The questioning developed no criminal conduct, nor any mental problems or treatment, and the responses raised no questions of judgment or reliability. Subject's comments indicated he is loyal to the United States; and he reported for himself, family, and associates, no involvement in or advocacy of force to overthrow the U.S. Government, or the use of force or violence to deny others their constitutional/legal rights. Samuel W. Bodman do hereby make the following voluntary statement to Bradley I. Parker, who has identified himself to me as a Special Agent in Charge of the Defense Investigative Service. I make this statement without any threats having been made against me or any promises extended to me. I certify that the following statement is true, complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge and belief and is made in good faith. I understand that a knowing and willful false statement can be punished by fine or imprisonment or both. (See U.S. Code, Title 18, Section 1001.)

My capacity as Representative of a Foreign Interest ("RFI") is as follows: I have served as a Director of the following foreign entities: Cabot Plastics Hong Kong Limited ("CPHKL"), Tai Po, Hong Kong, since 1987 and Nhumo S.A. de C.V. ("NU"), Bosques de las Lomas, Mexico since February 1991 (prior to June 1992, NU was doing business as Negroservia S.A. de C.V. in Bosques de las Lomas, Mexico). Since 1992, I was a Director of Negro de Humo Negromex ("NHN"), Bosques de las Lomas, Mexico, which merged with NU in June 1993. Since 1991, I have also served as a Consultative Council Representative (similar to a Director's position) of Capuava Carbonos Industriais, S.A. ("CCI"), Sao Paulo, Brazil. CPHKL, NU and CCI are the only foreign entities of which I have a titular role or for which I act as a representative. My specific duties as a Director of CPHKL and NU and as a Representative of CCI include evaluating business performance of each entity, encouraging growth and investment and making appropriate management changes or recommendations for such changes. Since all the aforementioned foreign entities are indirect subsidiaries of Cabot Corporation ("CC"), Boston, MA, I periodically describe business activities of the above companies to the CC Board of Directors. My duties as a Director or Representative of the aforementioned foreign companies are similar to my responsibilities as a Director of CC.

Regarding products of the above foreign entities, CPHKL produces plastic concentrates and NU and CCI both produce carbon black. Plastic concentrates are used in a variety of applications, as is carbon black. Paint, rubber tires and ink are the more common products which are made with carbon black. No military hardware is produced by any of the above foreign entities and their products are of a commercial nature. Due to its proximity to People's Republic of China ("PRC"), CPHKL does sell its products to companies in the PRC. NU has sold carbon black in the past into Cuba. I have no direct involvement in the sales or marketing of products by CPHKL, NU or CCI.

I do not have any personal financial investment/obligations to CPHKL, NU or CCI, or to any other foreign entity. I do not receive a salary or any remuneration from the above foreign entities. Less than 10% of my time is spent on duties as a RFI of the above firms, and compensation for that time is included in my salary from CC.

Due to the commercial nature of the products from the above foreign entities, I do not recognize or foresee any current or future conflict-of-interest situations between my RFI status and having a U.S. Security Clearance. If a conflict ever developed, I would not make a decision detrimental to the U.S. Government or non-governmental entity which would violate U.S. law because my policy-making decisions are based on U.S. law. Should such a conflict arise, CC policy has built-in procedures to deal effectively with the situation. Through open communication with Company management at the above foreign sites, and internal audit/control mechanisms, I would likely be personally aware of any potential conflict-of-interest situation. Subsequent action on my part would be notification to CC legal counsel, CC security office and appropriate U.S. Government authorities (FBI, etc.). Before deciding if CC would divest itself of the aforementioned foreign interests in order to engage in U.S. Government activities involving access to classified material, I would have to conduct an economic/business impact analysis of the gain or loss resulting from such action. My decision would be based on reasonable business judgment because my foremost obligation is to CC stockholders.

All the aforementioned foreign entities are production facilities, not involved in research or development. I have not provided any confidential Cabot scientific or technical information to anyone in a communist or formerly Soviet Union country. I have never been approached by anyone, foreign or domestic, who attempted to obtain information from me regarding my security clearance and/or access to classified material.

In July 1992, I traveled to Beijing, China for the opening of Shanghai Cabot Chemical Co., Ltd., Shanghai, China and visited the following officials: Mr. Zhu Rong Ji - Vice Premier, Central Government, PRC; Madame Gu Xiulian - Minister, Ministry of Chemical Industry ("MCI") PRC; Mr. Tan Zhushou - Vice Minister, MCI, PRC; Mr. Ron Yiren - Chairman, China International Trust and Investment Corp. ("CITIC"); Mr. Yang Guanggui - Vice Chairman, CITIC; and Mr. Huang Jichun - Vice-President, CITIC.

In June 1992, I was visited by the following Russians at CC, Boston, MA: Vladimir Louniov - Chairman, Interrepublican Confederation of Coal Workers Trade Unions; Evgeny Kroi - Vice President, Coal of Russia Corp; Semion Laevsky - Director, ByKovo Experimental Plant of Automatic Devices; Ivan Toherkes - Assistant Professor, Moscow Mining Institute; Victor Ilyin - Director, Prokopyevsk Plant and Olga Dumer, Interpreter.

The meetings in the PRC and with the Russians in Boston were strictly business-related and no hostile intelligence efforts were made to obtain information from me, nor was there any endeavor by any foreigner to establish a continuing personal relationship with me. While I have been a RFI for CC, I have had no other business meeting with a representative of a communist government or entity whose identity I can recall. Pursuant to the DOD Industrial Security Manual, DISCO was notified of the above contacts via letter dated February 1, 1993.


