1. [redacted] informed [redacted] of the desire to have a psychiatric program move along at the same time as the physiological one, which will be suggested by [redacted]. [redacted] had definite hopes that the contribution of [redacted] and [redacted] will be immediate and significant. He is going to be in Washington on Wednesday, 12 September, and will see them then. He may or may not stop in to see [redacted] that day.
