MEMORANDUM TO THE FILE

SUBJECT: Conversations with [REDACTED] in Washington - 12 September 1951

C 1. [REDACTED] agreed a full time literature surveyor might well be used. He suggested use of a graduate student who wished to earn money for a year before continuing his studies. [REDACTED] hoped that [REDACTED] would have some names to suggest.

C A 2. [REDACTED] was briefed concerning the potentialities of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. He stated he would suggest topics in the foreign field which they could investigate.

C A 3. He was doubtful if [REDACTED] would have more than one or two specific projects in mind at this time, but he felt that discussion of even one would make [REDACTED]'s trip to [REDACTED] worth while.
