SUBJECT : Drug Interrogation Research

1. This memorandum is to apprise you of precautionary steps that have been taken for the conduct of research in a potentially sensitive area, drug interrogation research. **SHORT DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY**

This study will examine the efficacy of using changes in verbal behavior as an index of an altered state of consciousness. This will be correlated with psychophysiological changes as well as extensive psychological tests. Critical subjects will be from psychiatric prison ward populations undergoing routine, but meaningful interviews. Particular attention will be paid to reduction of inhibition concerning critical information.
