



In accordance with instructions received from Mr. Ladd, a memorandum is being prepared which will reflect the names of individuals who have been interviewed, the names of individuals who are to be interviewed, as well as the names of individuals who will not be interviewed in connection with the over-all activity of the underground Government group to which Hiss and Chambers allegedly belonged.

In this connection, reference is made to the letter to the Washington Field Office dated January 19, 1949, which instructed that Office to interview numerous individuals for information in this connection.

In order that the memorandum requested by Lr. Ladd may be completed at an early date I called the Washington Field Office at 2:20 P.M., January 25, 1949, and talked with Special Agent Robert McCaslin, who was on Supervisor Delavigne's desk at that time. I explained the purpose of the call to Mr. McCaslin and advised him to furnish a memorandum to the Bureau immediately reflecting -

- (1) The names of the individuals who have been interviewed;
- (2) The names of the individuals who are to be interviewed not only by the Washington Field Office but by other offices at the request of the Washington Field Office;
- (3) The names of individuals who will not be interviewed with regard to this matter, together with the reason as to why they will not be interviewed.

Mr. McCaslin stated this matter would be handled promptly and the Bureau advised in the immediate future.

ACTION:

It is recommended that this memorandum be forwarded to the Espionage Section.

In the notes taken by Mr. A. A. BERLE, former Under-Secretary of State, during an interview with WHITTAKER CHAMBERS in September, 1939, appears the following notation:

BUNDATA (BONIAT) RENO connected with Baltimore Party Organizer - BENJAMIN (BUNDEY) FRIEDMAN, aliaNFIEID - then California - then Russia - now organizer for Baltimore and Washington of above ground party - underground connections."

The report of Special Agent JOHN T. REYNOLDS, dated February 1, 1943, at Washington, D. C., entitled, "B. MAFIELD, INTERNAL SECURITY - C, CUSTODIAL DETENTION", reflects that 10 membership books of the Communist Party covering the years 1938 and 1939 were signed by B. M. FIELD and made available to the Washington Field Office. The FBI Laboratory subsequently identified the signature on these books as identical with the signature of BENJAMIN FIELD, FBI #1465886, (Bureau File 100-24601). This individual also used the aliases ISADORE TRIEDMAN and ISAAC TRIEDMAN, according to his criminal record, although his aliases are not substantiated by fingerprints.

From the information available to the Washington Field Office, it appears that the Laboratory was unable to identify the signature of BENJAMIN FIELD, FBI #1465886, with the signature of MOSES MARRAGIN, a resident of Brooklyn, New York, (New York File 100-25957), although it appears that these individuals are probably identical.

Inasmuch as the BENJAMIN (BUNDEY) FRIEDMAN, alias FIELD, referred to by CHAMBERS was, according to CHAMBERS, an organizer for the Baltimore-Washington area in 1939, it is believed probably that this individual is identical with BENJAMIN FIELD, FBI #1465886, whose name appeared on the Communist Party membership books covering the period 1938 to 1939 DEFERRED PECCHANGE

There is some similarity between the names "BUNDEY" (as stated by CHALIBERS to be connected with RENO) and "BERNIE" (as stated by FRANKLIN RENO) as the person who introduced RENO to CHAMBERS. It is felt that these individuals may possibly be identical.



The editor, of course, should not be advised of the reason for securing the specimens. I told him it could be pointed out to the editor that it was not a matter affecting him in any way. Ir. Strickland advised this newspaper man had been cooperative in the past on other investigative matters.



Reference is made to the report of Special Agent FRANK G. JOHNSTONE in the captioned case dated December 24, 1948 and the report of Special Agent JESSE F. FARR dated December 30, 1946 at Baltimore, Maryland and entitled COGOG. INTERNAL SECURITY - C.

Considerable data appears in the above mentioned report dated December 30, 1946 starting on page 16 concerning the Communist Political Association Club at Aberdeen, Maryland. It is to be noted as a result of the investigation by this office, a number of individuals working in the Ballistics Research Laboratories and elsewhere on the Aberdeen Proving Ground were determined to be members of the Communist Political Association. It is to be noted on page 28 of this report under the heading JOSEPH JAFFEE, it is reported that WEISS and JAFFEE had complete access to all data concerning the proximity fuse. As reflected in both of the aforementioned reports, JAFFEE and five of the Aberdeen Proving Ground employees were discharged by the War and Navy Departments as a result of information concerning their membership in the Communist Party as furnished by this office.

Inasmuch as one of the individuals interviewed in regard to FRANKLIN VICTOR RENO_expressed the opinion that RENO was acquainted with those discharged and inasmuch as RENO filed a petition protesting their discharge, it is possible that this group was associated with RENO in the dissemination of information to an espionage apparatus subsequent to the 1938 date which he gave as his last contact with any members of the espionage ring.

It is also to be noted that Baltimore Confidential Informant Spring of 1948 advised that three of the individuals who had been fired at Aberdeen, IRVING SPECTOR, HARRY SPECTOR and ABRAHAM KOTELCHUCK, were considerably perturbed over the belief that they might be under investigation by the FBI. At that time, IRVING SPECTOR was reported to be extremely nervous and his wife was concerned about his health. Subsequent to that time, HARRY SPECTOR received considerable publicity because he was teaching school in this city and had been accused of having Communist sympathies. RECORDED - 62 1 23 3

In connection with the above-entitled case, Special Agent James T. Haverty has called to my attention that the Bureau has conducted an "LGE" investigation on one STEPHEN WARE, son of HAROLD WARE and grandson of Mother ELLA REEVES BLOOR. HAROLD WARE was reportedly leader of the CP underground in Washington, D.C. prior to about 1937.

The investigation of STEPHEN WARE, a Navy employee, reflected he was reported as one of the leaders of the Young Communist League in Chicago about 1939 but that no information of CP activities on his part was reported since that time. It is believed that WARE resided with his father in Washington, D.C. until about 1935, attending high school in that city prior to that time. It is also believed that WARE originally came from a small town in Maryland.

The above is being brought to the Bureau's attention with a view to seeing whether it might desire to have STEPHEN WARE interviewed as to the activities of his father and other members of the CP underground in Washington, D.C. about 1935.

On January 18, 1949, Insleman testified before the grand jury and when asked whether he was a Communist Party member during various years, he finally exclaimed, "I've never been a Communist!"

An examination was made by the New York Office of the Election Board records at New York City and it was found that Felix Inslemen had registered as a Communist for the years 1933 and 1934, giving his address as 314 East 122nd Street, New York City.

Photostatic copies of the Election Board records and known hand-writing specimens of Inslerman were furnished to the FBI laboratory for comparison of the handwriting appearing on each.

The FBI laboratory has concluded that the signatures of Felix A. Inslerman appearing on the Election Board records are identical with Inslerman's signatures which appear on several applications for employment. This identification has been furnished to the New York Office.



WHILE HAVING NO DEFINITE INFORMATION REGARDING HER RUSSIAN SYMPATHIES DURING THIS PERIOD. ISZARD AND HIS WIFE BOTH STATED THAT SINCE HER PRESENT EMPLOYMENT AND SINCE THE START OF WORLD WAR TWO. Reference is made to report of SA MAHLON F. COLLER dated January 24, 1949, at Detroit.

In interviewing ARVID WERNER JACOBSON the Agents received the impression that JACOBSON is tempermental, moody, and inclined to great depths of depression. He went to lengthy explanations, stating that he had done everything in his power to live down his past and re-establish himself as a respectable citizen. He stated that on his release from imprisonment in Finland he dedicated his life to public service and considers himself the founder of Alcoholics Anonymous. He has written two manuels on mechanical problems in advanced car designing used by the Ford Motor Company during the war and is presently working on a book regarding the theoretical mathematical approach to engineering problems for research engineers.

JACOBSON stated that, while it might be difficult to believe, his three years in solitary confinement had such an effect upon his mind that he is unable to recall the events surrounding his recruitment and that many things in his life prior to 1933 are complete blanks. In the form of a soliloguy he stated that should he be subject to any publicity in this matter his professional career would be ruined, all that he had worked for would be destroyed and his escape would be self-destruction which he had contemplated in the past.

During the lengthy interview, it was quite apparent that he could offer no additional information to that already furnished. Particularly was he unable to verify the incidents referred to by CHAMBERS, though he seemed to try delving back into his memory. JACOBSON appeared to be in earnest when speaking of suicide. He and his wife lost their only child a few years ago and said that should his past be again openly aired, he would have nothing to live for anymore.

In view of the foregoing no further interviews with JACOBSON Co. are contemplated without specific Bureau instructions.



YATES continued that he attended Fill Drep School at Fotstown, Pennsylvania with LOVETT for a period of six years of them they both were together at Yale University for two years. Direct their prep school years CHAMBERS attended a nearby prep school and through their school activities learned to know CHAMBERS well. During this period of time YATES described CHAMBERS as a Bolshevik, violent For Revolutionist, and a person who was always talking about the day of the Revolution. YATES did not know ALGER HISS and last contacted Company in 1914.

YATES further stated that he felt that CHAMBERS was a Communist during their prep school days and he felt that a man never chambers. As a result of this conviction, YATES feels that CHAMBERS is lying to the Management American Committee regarding ALGER HISS and on the basis of these line YATES feels that HISS is not guilty.

The following information is being brought to your attention for appropriete action.

The report of SA Joseph M. Kelly, dated December 23, 1948, at New York; Page 34 reflects that Chambers advised that he was introduced to "Vincent" Reno by J. Peters in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, probably in 1937. The same report, Page 59, reflects that Reno advised that he was introduced to Carl (Whittaker Chambers) in Philadelphia, by an individual known to him as "Bernie."

The same report, Page 39, reflects that a photograph of David Zimmerman, with aliance, was exhibited to Reno as being the individual possibly identical to "Bernie", and Reno railed to identify Simmerman with "Bernie." It is also noted that Chambers was reinterviewed, and he expressed the opinion that "Bernio" must be Zimmerman.

A thorough review of the information received to date by the Bureau in this case fails to reflect that a photograph of Alexander Stevens (J. Peters) has been exhibited to Reno. In the event that this action has not been taken, you should immediately forward a photograph of Alexander Stevens to the El Paso Office to be shown to Reno.

On January 12, 1949, THOMAS R. WALLACE, an employee of the Consolidated Gas, Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore, 531
East Madison Street, Baltimore, Maryland, advised that an agent had been attempting to contact him at his residence, 3417 Clay Street, N. E., Washington, D. C., concerning a typewriter supposedly owned by him.

WALLACE further stated that a Woodstock typewriter, serial number unknown to him, was purchased by WALLACE in 1939 or 1940 from the General Typewriter Exchange, 800 block F Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and sold by his wife, MARGARET E. WALLACE, during the summer of 1946 to a firm located somewhere on H Street, N. E., Washington, D. C. Owing to marital difficulties, WALLACE's wife would not tell him to whom she sold the typewriter; however, WALLACE advised that his wife knew exactly where she sold the typewriter and felt that, if she were contacted by an agent, she would disclose this information. WALLACE advised that his wife could be contacted at 3417 Clay Street, N. E., or at her place of work, Woolworth's Five and Ten Cent Store, Minnesota Avenue, one block below Benning Road, N. E., Washington, D. C. The Washington Field Office was notified by teletype on January 12, 1949, as to where MARGARET E. WALLACE could be contacted. WALLACE went on to say that it was possible that he had specimens from this typewriter in his possession which his wife possibly would not be able to locate, and that he would make a search for them when he returned to Washington, D. C., on January 14, 1949.

On January 17, 1949, WALLACE was recontacted and advised that he had made a search of his premises, 3417 Clay Street, N. E., Washington, D. C., and found one specimen which was typed by him between July and November, 1940, on the Woodstock typewriter formerly owned by him. KELLY, made at New York, January 21, 1949, entitled as above, in which lead is set forth for the New Haven office at Thomaston, Conn., to continue efforts to locate tourist home described by CHAMBERS as being the place where he, ALGER, and PRISCILLA HIES stopped overnight in the summer of 1937 while en route by automobile from Washington, D.C. to New Hampshire.

Reference is now made to reports of SA JOHN C. CARR, made at New Haven, dated January 17, 1949 and January 12, 1949, entitled as above, wherein it was reflected that it appears that CHAMBERS stayed at the Hotel Thomaston, formerly the Park Hotel, Thomaston, Connecticut, but that no register of guests for the pertinent period is presently available. It would appear that the New Haven office can conduct no further investigation in this matter inasmuch as all leads have been logically covered.

It is suggested that the New York office and the Bureau may desire to consider the possibility of driving CHAMBERS over the route which he claims was taken on their trip to New Hampshire for the purpose of determining if it was the Hotel Thomaston, formerly the Park Hotel, at which he and the HISSES remained for one night.

Rebulet Becember 22, 1948, requesting the Washington Field Office to verify the employment of AIGER HISS with the U. S. Senate Munitions Committee, more commonly known as the Nye Committee, from August 1934 until May 1935. It was also desired that the identity of fellow employees of AIGER HISS at the Nye Committee be ascertained in order that they might be interviewed concerning ALGER HISS: allegations that he first met WHITTAKER CHAMBERS while employed at the Nye Committee.

It is observed that AIGER HISS in testimony before the HCUA testified that he has never known WHITTAKER CHAMBERS as such and met him when the former was employed by the Nye Committee and CHAMBERS and he became acquainted when CHAMBERS sought information on which he desired to base a newspaper article. CHAMBERS, according to AIGER HISS, was known as GEORGE CROSLEY and was a free lance writer.

CHAMBERS, it is recalled, has advised that he first met AIGER HISS through their mutual activity in the Communist Party underground and primarily due to the fact that AIGER HISS was furnishing him, CHAMBERS, with confidential information secured from the files of the Federal Government.

Investigation has reflected that no personnel files as such were ever maintained by the Senate Munitions Committee and that all of the employees were on loan from some government agency. An examination of the files of the Senate Munitions Committee located in the National Archives reflects that approximately 100 individuals were employed by the Committee from 1933 to 1935.

An interview has been had with Mr. STEPHEN RAUSHENBUSH, who is an official of the Public Affairs Institute, 1100 - E Street, S. E., and who resides at 3503 Lowell Street, N. W., both Washington, D. C., who formerly was a supervising official of the Nye Committee, under whose direction AIGER HISS worked. Mr. RAUSHENBUSH advised that the individuals listed below under the appropriate offices are thought by him to be acquainted with HISS. However, RAUSHENBUSH stated that he cannot vouch for the degree of acquaintanceship between these individuals and AIGER HISS. RAUSHENBUSH said that HISS made one brief trip to New York City. while employed by the Nye Committee and that consequently, other members of the Nye Committee working in New York may have a slight acquaintance with HISS.

In this connection, the New York Division is referred to PAUL J. KERN, who according to RAUSHENBUSH, is now a highly placed city official in the city government of New York City. KERN, formerly an investigator for the Nye Committee, may be able to furnish additional names of individuals with whom HISS is acquainted. It should be noted that RAUSHENBUSH stated that HISS worked for the Nye Committee only about seven months. RAUSHENBUSH stated that he had no close personal relationship with AIGER HISS and that although he has seen HISS several times since the dissolution of the Nye Committee, these meetings were in the nature of social gatherings where each happened to be present at the same affair. He said that he has not been in HISS! home nor has HISS been in his, RAUSHENBUSH!s, home.

It should also be noted that RAUSHENBUSH stated that he believed HISS to be innocent. RAUSHENBUSH recalled that he had been interviewed by newspapers when HISS stated that RAUSHENBUSH might have known WHITTAKER CHAMBERS under the alias of GEORGE CROSLEY. RAUSHENBUSH stated he could not recall CHAMBERS as CHAMBERS or as GEORGE CROSLEY, and upon viewing the pictures of CHAMBERS taken in 1931 and 1936, stated that he could not recall ever having met this individual.

Offices to which this letter is addressed are requested to interview individuals set out below, looking toward the recovery of any typewritten material in the possession of these individuals which originated with HISS. Efforts should also be made in these interviews to fully develop any information which they may have in connection with HISS! personal affairs. Efforts should also be made linking HISS and CHAMBERS. The enclosed photographs of CHAMBERS should be displayed at the time of the interviews. It should be noted that HISS has denied that he has seen CHAMBERS since about December, 1936 and this denial forms a large part of the basis for HISS! present indictment for perjury.

Bureau teletype to all SACS dated January 10, 1949, will furnish additional background information. It is pointed out that all investigation is supposed to be completed and reported by January 31, 1949.

The New York Division, at New York City, is requested to interview:

PAUL J. KERN, present address unknown; last reported to be at 140 West 34th Street, New York City. KERN, according to RAUSHENBUSH, is presently a highly placed official in New York City Government and was an investigator for the Nye Committee.
