

## FBI FOIPA Addendum

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

### Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the [www.fbi.gov/foia](http://www.fbi.gov/foia) website.
- (ii) **Intelligence Records.** To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

### Part 2: The standard responses below apply to all requests for records on individuals:

- (i) **Requests for Records about any Individual—Watch Lists.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any individual's name on a watch list pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(7)(E) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that watch list records do or do not exist.
- (ii) **Requests for Records about any Individual—Witness Security Program Records.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could identify any participant in the Witness Security Program pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(3) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(3), 18 U.S.C. 3521, and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.
- (iii) **Requests for Records for Incarcerated Individuals.** The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any incarcerated individual pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (b)(7)(F), and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

### Part 3: General Information:

- (i) **Record Searches.** The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. A standard search normally consists of a search for main files in the Central Records System (CRS), an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. Unless specifically requested, a standard search does not include references, administrative records of previous FOIPA requests, or civil litigation files. - (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) **Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets.** The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks – often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative “FBI file.” An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. For a fee, individuals can request a copy of their Identity History Summary Check. Forms and directions can be accessed at [www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/identity-history-summary-checks](http://www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/identity-history-summary-checks). Additionally, requests can be submitted electronically at [www.edo.cjis.gov](http://www.edo.cjis.gov). For additional information, please contact CJIS directly at (304) 625-5590.
- (iv) **National Name Check Program (NNCP).** The mission of NNCP is to analyze and report information in response to name check requests received from federal agencies, for the purpose of protecting the United States from foreign and domestic threats to national security. Please be advised that this is a service provided to other federal agencies. Private Citizens cannot request a name check.

## EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

### SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information ( A ) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, ( B ) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, ( C ) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, ( D ) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, ( E ) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or ( F ) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

### SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552a

- (d)(5) information compiled in reasonable anticipation of a civil action proceeding;
- (j)(2) material reporting investigative efforts pertaining to the enforcement of criminal law including efforts to prevent, control, or reduce crime or apprehend criminals;
- (k)(1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to an Executive order in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy, for example, information involving intelligence sources or methods;
- (k)(2) investigatory material compiled for law enforcement purposes, other than criminal, which did not result in loss of a right, benefit or privilege under Federal programs, or which would identify a source who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(3) material maintained in connection with providing protective services to the President of the United States or any other individual pursuant to the authority of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3056;
- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

By referenced communications, a list of the subjects in the investigation and trial of Ethel and Julius Rosenberg was furnished each field office. Also furnished each field office was a list of the names on the Government's Witness List relating to the investigation and trial of Julius and Ethel Rosenberg. The list of subjects and individuals appearing on the Government's Witness List will therefore not be repeated in this communication.

For your information captioned FOIA suit has been in litigation for approximately two years. During the course of this litigation, on 8/1/75, the Court issued an Order that no documents maintained by the FBI be destroyed. Due to the file destruction moratorium then in effect, that Court Order was not brought to your attention in 1975. Due to the continuing litigation and current discussion regarding reinstitution of a file destruction program in the near future, you are hereby being advised of the Order of the Court in this matter. Accordingly, no files maintained in your office (origin or auxiliary office) relating to any of the main subjects or individuals appearing on the Government's Witness List should be destroyed. Informant stated that STONE described himself as a left wing liberal, and spoke on his impression of Russia. Commenting on Russian journalism, STONE stated that the Russian newspapers do not really say anything, and that they all seem to be written by the same person. Informant mentioned that STONE commented on the Russian legal setup by stating that although it is reformed once in a while, the changes are kept secret. STONE stated that Russia is a Socialist Country, because there is no private property there. He predicted that Socialism would come to the United States, and that radicals must face up to the problems of maintaining democracy and nationalizing property.

Informant mentioned that STONE had stated that the Soviets did not allow any foreign newspapers in Russia, and that when publications printed in the United States are available in Russia it is only when they contain articles which praised or gave favorable facts about the Soviet Union. Informant also advised that STONE had attacked the Soviet legal system, stating that it was impossible to receive a fair trial, as the court is under the jurisdiction of the Soviet Police as it has been since the days of the Czar. Informant advised that STONE concluded his speech stating that neither communism or socialism will succeed in Russia until they see fit to give the people democracy along with it.

# Conservative club hears Soviet defector

The Soviet Union has a well defined strategy for world domination, is seeking the unilateral disarmament of the U.S. through a so-called "peace" movement, is now making plans for a nuclear attack against the U.S., a top Soviet defector told the Alexandria Conservative Club.

The speaker was Igor Glagolev, who served as chief of the section on disarmament of the Institute of World Economy and International Relations of the Academy of Sciences of the U.S.S.R. He was also a consultant to Soviet officials concerned with International Security Arms Control Negotiations and prepared working papers for the chief Soviet negotiators for SALT I.

Dr. Glagolev defected to the U.S. in 1976 and now is director of the Association for the Cooperation of Democratic Countries.

Dr. Glagolev painted a bleak picture of the prospects for peace by describing the Soviets as eminently aggressive.

"Most Soviet leaders are experts in nuclear war," he said. "They are already planning a nuclear attack on the U.S. Their main strategy was announced last year at the 26th Congress of the Communist Party in

Moscow. The main point is would domination and the main method is armed struggle."

This and the fact that all long range Soviet weapons are aimed at the U.S., Glagolev feels, has been concealed from Americans (by the media he says.) So have the statistics that reveal Soviet superiority in nuclear weapons.

"The Salt I treaty called for Soviet superiority, but the Russian leaders speak only of 'equality' and those in the West echo their words," Glagolev noted.

He indicated that the Soviets are now six times as strong as the West in nuclear weapons, and eight times stronger in chemical weapons. Moscow has 12,000 anti-aircraft strategic missiles while the U.S. has none, he said.

Complimenting President Reagan for understanding the nature of growing Soviet strength, Glagolev warned that the U.S. must recognize its weakness if it is ever to restore military equality, much less superiority.

He scoffed at the idea that nuclear war is "unwinnable."

"First of all, any nuclear power can win a war against any non-nuclear power. Remember the U.S. and Japan? Secondly, a strong nuclear power can defeat a weak nuclear power. Consider

the Soviet Union in a war against Israel."

Although the Soviet Union is currently able to destroy the bulk of U.S. weapons and although new Soviet technology is making U.S. submarines vulnerable, the situation can still be turned around, he said.

Glagolev would like to see the U.S. restore strategic equality and stop providing credits and advanced technology to the Communist world. He also called for U.S. aid to those fighting Communist aggression, such as the freedom fighters in Afghanistan and Jonas Savimbi's UNITA forces in Angola.

He harshly criticized the peace movement in the U.S. and Europe and the campaign for a nuclear freeze as being "manipulated from Moscow through the Soviet-created World Peace

Council."

While he was still working for the Soviet government, Glagolev recalled, "Leaders of your 'peace' groups, such as SANE and the Federation of American Scientists, came to Moscow for instructions. I met all of them there.

"Once when I was visiting in New York, a representative of the Federation of American Scientists came to me for instructions.

"The Communist Party of the Soviet Union appoints all members of the World Peace Council and controls all of these movements. They want the unilateral disarmament of the West, and the 'nuclear freeze' movement is aiming at that result."

He would like to see the Voice of America and Radio Free Europe used far more effectively in

the battle for the minds of the Russian people.

"Once I recall in Moscow, the VOA announced that there would be a non-Communist art exhibition in a private apartment. When I went there, thousands of people lined the street waiting to get in. The VOA announcement was the only publicity that exhibit received," Glagolev related.

The majority of the Russian people, he said, hate Communism.

"They are our best allies and we should do everything to help them rather than continuing to assist the governments which enslave them."

To change the Soviet system Glagolev cited the need to stop providing the Soviet leadership with credits and technological transfers.





My wife, who is a student of the Russian language as well as a Doctor of Mathematics, will accompany me. We

Therefore, if it is possible, and convenient, for you to signify my interest in discussions to those persons to whom these books are sent I should be especially indebted.



The NYO has summarized the above letter in the LHM in an effort to further conceal the confidential source.

Boston is requested to ascertain if the writer of this communication is identical to the son of the long-time CP member, ISIDOR FEINSTEIN STONE. If identical, Boston should handle in accordance with instructions contained in Section 105K of the Manual of Instructions.

Boston should also be alerted to the fact that the Soviet Intelligence Service is especially interested in cultivating and using persons of STONE's caliber. It is extremely possible that if STONE is the son of the long-time CP member, the KGB may be aware of this and could possibly utilize some way to approach STONE while he is in Moscow.

MEMORANDUM FOR FILE:

Re: Interview with Dr. Jeremy J. Stone

In response to Dr. Stone's letter to [redacted] a copy of which is attached, I called Dr. Stone on January 7, and arranged to meet with him on January 8 at 2:30 p.m. in my office. [redacted] was present during most of the meeting.

In response to our inquiry, Dr. Stone described the Federation of American Scientists as a nonprofit organization interested in legislative action with respect to issues affecting science and society. With respect to himself, Dr. Stone stated that he held a doctorate in mathematics, although he was not actively pursuing that discipline at this time. He indicated that he had recently written on political subjects, and that his current activity was directed toward political and social problems.

Dr. Stone stated that he was interested in our procedures for handling national security and other authorized wiretapping. He was told that we had specific procedures for handling court-ordered wiretapping which we would outline for him, but that we would not discuss national security wiretapping and that this aspect of the subject should properly be discussed with the Federal agencies involved.

Dr. Stone expressed dissatisfaction with our refusal to discuss national security wiretapping; he stated that one of his concerns is that uncontrolled cooperation between the "bureaucracies" of the Telephone Company and the F.B.I. was a distinct possibility and would impose a real hazard to the legitimate privacy of individuals. He expressed a strong feeling that this area was a legitimate concern for organizations such as his, and that a refusal to discuss the subject was unwarranted.

We repeated that we would not discuss national security wiretapping, and that anything that was said did not apply to this area. With respect to court-ordered wiretapping, we stated that our practice was that an employee of the Company would inspect the court order to determine that it was valid on its face before any cooperation was given. Dr. Stone asked to see the form on which a record of such inspection was made. He stated that the procedure for inspection would undoubtedly require a form and he appeared skeptical of our statements with respect to our practice. He continued to talk of the action of the F. B. I. and

appeared to be ignoring the distinction between national security and other lawful interceptions. We again pointed out that we were discussing only procedures in court-ordered interceptions, and further told him that the assistance provided in such cases was ordinarily limited to cable and pair information, and that additional assistance was only provided under unusual circumstances. We stated that, to our knowledge, additional assistance in no case had included the actual connection of the tap by employees of our Company.

Dr. Stone inquired about our handling of requests for line checks by subscribers who suspect a tap. We told him that a check would be made, and that the customer would be advised whether or not evidence of tampering was found. Taps would be reported to law enforcement agencies to determine if they were court-ordered and to afford opportunity for investigation if unlawful, but that the customer would be advised in any event.

Dr. Stone asserted that our statements were inconsistent with testimony by Bell System witnesses at Congressional hearings. He indicated that he was referring to testimony before the Long Committee, and we pointed out that the policy we were discussing was formulated to implement the provisions of the Omnibus Crime Control Bill of 1968 and that the practices were not necessarily applicable prior to that time. Dr. Stone requested the number of such inquiries from subscribers, and the results of our investigations. We indicated that we would see what information was available. He asked if reports of such activities were made to the F. C. C., and we said that we did not know whether any such reports were required, but that if required, they were undoubtedly made. Dr. Stone remarked that there was some conflict in testimony he had read concerning whether or not such reports were made.


Discussing the handling of customer complaints, we pointed out that a report to the suspect was required by the law within a short period following termination of the interception; Dr. Stone later indicated that he was not aware of this provision.

Dr. Stone asked how we would feel about impersonation of Company employees by law enforcement officials engaged in interceptions. He was told that we would not like such a practice. Dr. Stone asserted that such action was wide spread and shouldn't something be done by the Company about it. We replied that we had no knowledge of such impersonations, and since our employees were not in uniform it was difficult to distinguish between a Company employee and other craftsmen wearing tool belts. Dr. Stone again asserted that the practice was wide spread; that our craftsmen knew all about it; and that the Company should investigate the matter.

Dr. Stone asked if our statements reflected policy throughout the Bell System: He was told that we were speaking only for our particular Company, and that practices might or might not vary to some extent among other companies; this was a national problem as to which there had been discussions among the System companies, but the practices adopted by this Company reflected its view of proper procedures in the light of its particular situation.

Dr. Stone questioned whether the design of our plant facilitated unlawful tapping, and referred to some purported instance in New York where private lines had been wired with the connivance of craftsmen to permit dialing in on "thousands of lines." I indicated that I had no knowledge of the particular instances to which he referred, and stated that the technical aspects were beyond my competence. Dr. Stone indicated that his organization had the capacity to develop information in this area.

Dr. Stone indicated that he would like to pursue this subject further with employees in the security organization actually administering our practices and with linemen actually working in the City. I did not encourage him to believe that we would comply, but indicated we would consider this request and his request for information concerning the number of requests for line checks and the results of our investigations.

As I explained to you when you were kind enough to grant me an interview with yourself and [Redacted]

[Redacted]  
the Federation of American Scientists is looking into the question of privacy of communications with a view to informing our members. I have left you with three requests. I wanted to know the number of persons who had asked C & P to check their lines with a view to possible eavesdropping. I wanted to speak to the management of the security department that conducts such checks. And I wanted the privilege of interviewing some of the men who deal directly with customers in installing and checking phones. I appreciate your willingness to consider these requests and I look forward to your response.

As I mentioned to you over the telephone, I am still confused about certain questions and wonder if, for the sake of precision, I might write you about them. The fact of the matter is that I have received conflicting reports on some of these questions.

1. As far as is known to C & P, representatives of other Government agencies do not a) own trucks [Redacted] that are designed to give the impression that they are telephone company trucks; b) send their personnel into homes along with C & P personnel (whether with Government warrants or otherwise) in such a way as to create the illusion that both are repair men c) otherwise represent themselves directly or indirectly, as telephone company personnel. Is this correct?

2. As far as is known to C & P, has any telephone company employee ever been disciplined or fired for electronic evesdropping whether authorized or unauthorized. How common is this?

3. You have advised me that the telephone company does not "place the taps" that may be authorized by court order. Does it, however, a) lease lines for that purpose b) supervise the placing of the taps c) otherwise cooperate in the placing of the tap. In the case of court-ordered evesdropping that may use the telephone lines, does the telephone company cooperate with law-enforcement officials whose warrant is to evesdrop electronically on conversations not taking place over the phone, but who wish to use the telephone on the premises (or its lines) for eyesdropping purposes. Does it, for example, supervise the placement of suitable devices on telephones?

4. You have advised me that, apart from national security evesdropping, the telephone company advises persons on whose lines evesdropping devices are found that such devices have been found, even if the devices were placed by court order. You said that this is done after the Department of justice is notified. May I see a blank copy of a form advising a private party that evesdropping had been going on on his line? How many persons were advised that such devices had been found over the last few years? How many devices have been found? How many persons issued requests for inspection of their lines? Are reports of these statistics made to the F.C.C.?

5. Does the telephone company have written procedures for verifying and handling requests of the Federal Government for cooperation in national security evesdropping cases? Is it satisfied that all requests made to it, in this regard, by the Justice Department, military intelligence agencies and/or the CIA were personally authorized by the Attorney General acting for the President?


6. Has the telephone company found evidence of wiretapping by Soviet or Eastern European agents?

7. Has the telephone company ever uncovered a bugging device in the office, or at the home, of a Congressman or Senator? I do not wish to know particulars of a private nature, of course.

Let me thank you in advance for helping me with these questions. As you know, a sizable number of persons seriously question the security of their telephone lines. A complete and full answer to these questions would, I am sure, allay many of the anxieties my members feel.
