On July 6, 2012, Special Agent (SA) Gabriel Andrews reviewed text within, and public Internet postings regarding, the book "We Are Anonymous", written by Parmy Olson (Olson), London Bureau Chief at Forbes Magazine. The following excerpts and posts were found to pertain to MATTHEW KEYS' activity on the #InternetFeds chat room:

In "We Are Anonymous", page 446, Olson writes, "Owen's quote 'Switch is basically under a shoot on sight watch list' comes from screenshots of the #InternetFeds chat room made by freelance journalist Matthew Keys, which were e-mailed to me by Keys in early 2011. Keys was invited to observe the goings-on in InternetFeds from December of 2010 to January of 2011. He used the nickname AESCracked."

Also on page 446, Olson writes, "Details about #InternetFeds gradually usurping #command as an organizational hub popular with Anonymous hackers come from Topiary, Kayla, and two other hackers who were in the channel. Further description of dialogue and content from discussions in the channel comes from scores of screenshots provided by Matthew Keys."

On a Twitter post dated May 25, 2012, MATTHEW KEYS, username @ProducerMatthew, wrote "This is the book I'm in. You should think about buying it." In this post, he linked to the book "We Are Anonymous" on the shopping website amazon.com, and cc'd Parmy Olson's username @parmy.

On May 28, 2012, Parmy Olson responded to KEYS' twitter post with one of her own, stating "Cheers for that - it all helps. And you were a great source."
