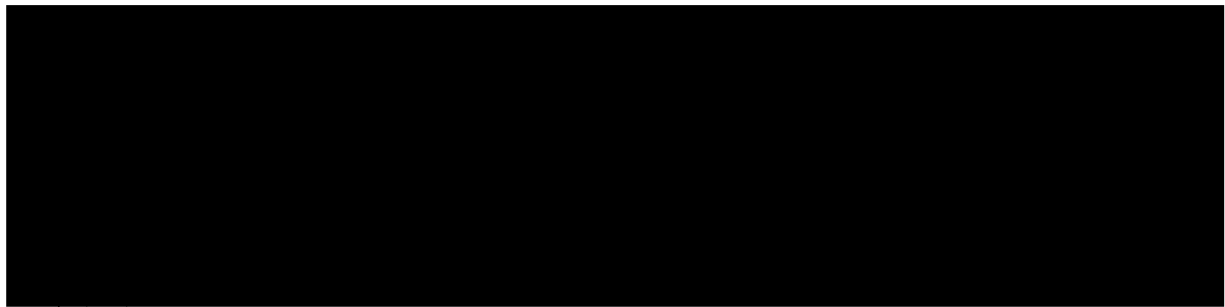

1. Four unidentified members of the Rumanian Iron Guard have been given teaching posts in Spanish universities; others have been given scholarships. Several have been given work with Spanish newspapers and one physician who is a member of the Guard is permitted to practice medicine. Iron Guardists in Spain are supported by the Falange, the Army and Church circles. Prat y Soutzo, former Spanish Minister to Bucharest, is largely responsible for Spanish support of the Iron Guard.

2. [REDACTED] Prince Nicolae believes that he can unite the Iron Guard around himself, thus taking a first step toward the unification of the Rumanian emigration. During his visit to Spain Nicolae reportedly made an excellent impression in Spanish society.

3. Nicolae Dumitrescu is presently recognized by the Spanish Government as unofficial Rumanian representative in Spain. Passports validated by Dumitrescu are recognized by the Spanish Government.
