'LEASE DELIVER THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE TO CHARLES POWELL FROM BRENT SCOWCROFT AT OPENING OF BUSINESS.

EAR CHARLES:

IS WE GO THROUGH THE THIRD WEEK OF WAR, I THOUGHT I MIGHT STEP BACK IND OFFER YOU A GENERAL OVERVIEW OF PROGRESS IN THE GULF. I WOULD BELCOME YOUR COMMENTS. WE ARE THINKING ABOUT PUTTING TOGETHER A FILITARY BRIEFING TEAM THAT MIGHT COME BY LONDON IN THE NEAR FUTURE IND SHARE AN EVEN MORE DETAILED PICTURE WITH THE PRIME MINISTER, SUPPLEMENTING THE INFORMATION WE ARE ALREADY SHARING DAY BY DAY.

THE MILITARY PICTURE IS QUITE PROMISING. THE FIRST PHASE OF OUR AIR AMPAIGN IS ESSENTIALLY COMPLETE. THE IRAQI AIR FORCE AND AIR DEFENSE SYSTEM IS NOW POWERLESS TO INTERFERE WITH OUR OPERATIONS. IE BELIEVE THE FLIGHT OF SOME OF THEIR AIRCRAFT TO IRAN IS SYMPTOMATIC OF A DESPERATE JUDGMENT THAT THIS WAS THE ONLY WAY TO HAVE EVEN A CHANCE OF PRESERVING SOME OF THEIR BETTER AIRCRAFT FOR THE FUTURE. IE HAVE NOTED THE ASSURANCES FROM TEHRAN ABOUT THESE AIRCRAFT. IE DOUBT THEY WILL BE REEMPLOYED IN THE WAR AGAINST US. WE HAVE IEEN NO SIGNS OF PREPARATION FOR SUCH USE AND IT WOULD BE DIFFICULT O PREPARE AND MAINTAIN THE AIRCRAFT FOR SUCH OPERATIONS WHILE THEY (EMAIN IN IRAN. THE IRANIANS WILL DISPOSE OF THESE AIRCRAFT IN ACCORDANCE WITH IRAN'S INTERESTS. IF THEY ARE USED AGAINST US, IE WILL BE READY TO DEAL WITH THAT.

THER OBJECTIVES IN THE INITIAL PORTION OF THE AIR CAMPAIGN INCLUDED THE DISRUPTION OF IRAQ'S NUCLEAR, CHEMICAL, AND BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS APABILITY AND DEGRADATION OF ITS NATIONAL COMMAND AND CONTROL TYSTEM. THOSE OBJECTIVES HAVE BEEN ACHIEVED. WHERE PARTICULAR ACILITIES SUFFERED ONLY PARTIAL DAMAGE, WE ARE NOW FOLLOWING UP TO INISH THE JOB. NATIONAL COMMAND AND CONTROL, ALONG WITH COMMAND AND CONTROL IN KUWAIT, CONTINUES TO BE HIT (19 OF 20 NATIONAL COMMAND ACILITIES HAVE BEEN ATTACKED) AND CONTINUES TO DETERIORATE.

RAG RETAINS SUBSTANTIAL STOCKS OF CHEMICAL WEAPONS. ALTHOUGH SOME, UCH AS MUSTARD GAS, MAY POSE A THREAT FOR SOME TIME TO COME, THE IERVE AGENTS WILL DETERIORATE IN WEEKS AND BAGHDAD WILL HAVE IFFICULTY PRODUCING MORE OR FILLING THEM INTO MUNITIONS. IRAQ'S PEFENSE INDUSTRIES, ELECTRICAL POWER GENERATION, AND PETROCHEMICAL LANTS HAVE ALL SUFFERED SEVERE DAMAGE AS WELL.

HAVE ALREADY BEGUN THE SECOND PHASE OF THE CAMPAIGN: THE ISOLATION IND DESTRUCTION OF IRAQ'S FORCES IN KUWAIT. I SHOULD NOTE HERE THAT, LITHOUGH WE CONTINUE TO GIVE ATTENTION TO THE SCUD THREAT (PERHAPS 50-200 SORTIES A DAY), THIS EFFORT HAS ALREADY PAID OFF IN REDUCED

IUMBERS OF MISSILE ATTACKS AND IS NOT AN UNDUE BURDEN ON THE OVERALL AMPAIGN. THERE IS ABUNDANT EVIDENCE THAT WE HAVE DISRUPTED IRAQ'S IBILITY TO SUPPLY ITS FORCES IN KUWAIT AND THAT THE BOMBING IS TAKING IN INCREASING TOLL ON THE FORCES THEMSELVES. IT ALSO APPEARS THAT OVER 75% OF THE IRAGI NAVY HAS BEEN SUNK OR DISABLED, AND SURVIVING TRAFT ARE INTERESTED ONLY IN THEIR OWN SURVIVAL. AS YOU KNOW, YOUR FORCES HAVE MADE AN ESPECIALLY LARGE CONTRIBUTION TO THIS NAVAL EFFORT.

RECENT TRADI OFFENSIVE PROBES INTO SAUDI ARABIA, ALONG WITH ATTEMPTS TO REPOSITION THEIR FORCES — POSSIBLY FOR FURTHER DEFENSIVE ACTION — HAVE OFFERED NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR OUR TRADE WE BELIEVE OUR STRIKES MAY ALREADY HAVE BROKEN UP AT LEAST ONE ATTACK BY III CORPS AND HAVE CAUSED HEAVY LOSSES TO TRADE INITS. THE REPUBLICAN GUARDS ARE BEING HIT DAY AND NIGHT. ALTHOUGH THERE IS SADNESS HERE ABOUT ANY LOSS OF OUR SOLDIERS AND AIRMEN, TRADES APPARENT EFFORT TO EMBROIL US IN COSTLY GROUND BATTLES IS PROVING COSTLY ONLY FOR BAGHDAD. THERE ARE SIGNS OF MORALE PROBLEMS IN THE TRADE UNITS — ONE INFANTRY DIVISION IS REPORTING THAT THOUSANDS OF ITS TROOPS HAVE DISAPPEARED FROM THE RANKS.

THERE MAY WELL BE ADDITIONAL MISSILE ATTACKS OR OFFENSIVE SALLIES. THE THREAT OF CHEMICAL FEAPONS USE IS QUITE HIGH, ALTHOUGH I BELIEVE WE ARE PREPARED TO MEET IT. THE AIR CAMPAIGN WILL CONTINUE. WE WILL NOT BE DRAWN INTO LAUNCHING ANY GROUND CAMPAIGN BEFORE WE ARE READY, OR BEFORE SUCH ACTION IS NECESSARY TO ACHIEVE OUR GOALS. RECENT AIR ATTACKS MAYE SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCED IRAQ'S ABILITY TO LAUNCH ATTACKS THAT MOULD REQUIRE A SUBSTANTIAL COUNTER-OFFENSIVE BY THE MULTINATIONAL FORCES.

POLITICALLY THE COALITION REMAINS SOLID. OUR POSITION ON WHAT SADDAM MUST DO TO END THE WAR IS UNCHANGED. ALTHOUGH WE ARE ALREADY WORKING ON THE RANGE OF ISSUES INVOLVED IN WAR TERMINATION AND POSTWAR ARRANGEMENTS, AND WILL WANT TO DISCUSS THESE QUESTIONS IN GREATER DETAIL WITH YOU SOON, THERE HAS BEEN SOME DISCUSSION ABOUT QUICK CONVENING OF A COMPREHENSIVE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE TO ADDRESS ALL OF THE POLITICAL ISSUES IN THE MIDDLE EAST. AS YOU MIGHT GUESS, WE THINK SUCH PLANS ARE PREMATURE.

I LOOK FORWARD TO SPEAKING AGAIN WITH YOU SOON.
