

**TUESDAY, JULY 27, 1993**

Breakfast with Woolsey going over essentially the issue of Bosnia here, looks like what they're saying is that this thing is gonna end, the plane is coming in for a landing and it looks like the show is about over. An issue on the way Woolsey is conducting himself is very strange, he's very much into the weeds on the technical issues, he's had alot of trouble up on the Hill because he's so adamant about any cuts in his budget, Tony Lake says he's just cheesed all kinds of people off by trying to work around the Chairmen to preserve his budget. He was not invited by Tony Lake to the working group that met in my office on the Iraqi targets because essentially he has such a poor relationship with Colin Powell. On thursday Colin Powell told me that Thursday the 29th, Colin Powell tells me that he's over insisting on briefings which he's not entitled to, Colin is going to try and have a breakfast meeting with him to bury the hatchet, it's a very, very strange performance.

Briefed by Slocombe, Carter, Allison, John Gordon irked it all before the meeting with Morozov, had the meeting with Morozov, signed the MOU and had a lunch with them, pushing Morozov pretty hard on the early denuclearization and finally at lunch he suggested that maybe we could detarget the missiles. When I asked him about the fact that these missiles were aimed at the U.S. and how could we help the Ukraine if they weren't doing anything about missiles aimed at the U.S., he said well let's take the missiles apart. Let's take the guidance out of the missiles, maybe that would be a compromise. Anyway DOD here are all pretty much associated with the early deactivation initiative.

Dinner that night at Anderson House with the Ukrainians, in the middle I got calls from Tony Lake and Madeline Albright that the French, who got shelled in Sarajevo on Sunday are pushing to have the UNPROFOR safe havens issue being brought forth and using air strikes to protect the UNPROFOR forces and particular to protect the French here. We haven't got that force up in place, we haven't notified members of congress, phone calls back and forth, being pulled out of this reception. Talked to Walt about it and he's going to try to see where we are in terms of having notified Congress.
