SUBJECT: INDIAN NUCLEAR PROGRAM

REFERENCE: STATE 194929

1. USAEC SCIENTIFIC REPRESENTATIVE RAMSEY INTERVIEWED DR. G. C. LAWRENCE, PRESIDENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY CONTROL BOARD AND DR. D. H. DEWAR, CHIEF SPECIAL ADVISER ON JULY 9, REGARDING RESULTS RECENT SAFEGUARDS INSPECTION RAJASTAN ATOMIC POWER PLANT (RAPP-I) AND CANADA INDIA REACTOR (CIR) BY AECB INSPECTORS.

- 2. LAWRENCE SAID SCOPE OF CIR INSPECTION LIMITED TO SURVEY OF CANADIAN SUPPLIED FUEL. HE NOTED INSPECTION SO LIMITED WAS FUTILE FOR DETECTION OF WEAPONS ACTIVITY.
- 3. LAWRENCE REVEALED INDIANS DISCHARGING INDIA-PRODUCED FUEL IRRADISTED IN CIR AT LOW EXPOSURE WHICH PRODUCES WEAPONS GRADE PLUTONIUM. DR. DEWAR NOTED THAT MAX OUTPUT OF 12KG. PER YEAR FROM REACTOR POSSIBLE.
- 4. LAWRENCE SAID THERE MAY BE THO REASONS FOR SHORT EXPOSURE:
- (1) WEAPONS GRADE PLUTONIUM PRODUCTION, AND (2) CORROSION OF FUEL CLAD IN CIR NECESSITATING PREMATURE DISCHARGE. HE SAID TESTS SHOWED INDIAN FABRICATED FUEL OF GOOD QUALITY BUT CORROSION HAD BEEN PROBLEM IN EARLY OPERATION.
- 5. LAWRENCE COULD NOT COMMENT ON INDIAN REPROCESSING OPERATION

AS ACCESS WAS NEITHER SOUGHT NOR VOLUNTERRED THIS INSPECTION.

6. IN THE OPINION OF THE AEC SCIENTIFIC REPRESENTATIVE HERE, THE UNSETTLING OTE DISCOVERY UNGTE REFERRED TO IN PARAGRAPH 3 OF STATE'S 194949 IS PROBABLY THE EARLY DISCHARGE OF FUEL REFLECTING POSSIBLE PRODUCTION OF WEAPONS GRADE PLUTONIUM.

7. LAWRENCE SAID THAT AECB COULD ONLY SPECULATE ON INDIAN DEVELOPMENT OF WEAPONS DEVICES. HE SAID NO OTHER EVIDENCE, SUCH AS ELECTRONIC DEVELOPMENT OR SPECIAL METALLURGY ASSOCIATED WITH WEAPONS DEVELOPMENT, WAS OBSERVED.
