1. (C) YOUR VISIT MAY 1-2 CONTINUES AN INTENSE ROUND OF HIGH-LEVEL ROK-U.S. DIPLOMATIC CONTACTS WHICH BEGAN WITH UNDER SECRETARY PICKERING'S RECENT TALKS IN SEOUL AND CULMINATES WITH PRESIDENT KIM DAE-JUNG'S STATE VISIT TO CONFIDENTIAL

YOUR MEETINGS HERE CAN ALSO IMPRESS UPON THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF THE ROKG THAT PLANS FOR THE JUNE SUMMIT SHOULD FOCUS NOT ONLY ON CREATING AN ATMOSPHERE OF MUTUAL CANDOR AND TRUST (OFTEN LACKING IN OUR RELATIONS WITH PREVIOUS ROK ADMINISTRATIONS), BUT ON CONCRETE RESULTS AS WELL. PUBLICLY, WE WOULD EXPECT PRESIDENT KIM TO LAY TO REST ANY LINGERING DOUBTS ABOUT KOREA'S COMMITMENT TO KEDO, FREE TRADE AND OPEN MARKETS. PRIVATELY, THE TWO PRESIDENTS COULD MOVE BEYOND IMMEDIATE CONCERNS TO CONSIDER KIM'S EFFORTS AT RAPPROCHEMENT WITH JAPAN AND HIS CONCEPT OF A "NATO FOR NORTHEAST ASIA." END SUMMARY.

3. (C) THE PAST FEW WEEKS HAVE SEEN A PALPABLE EASING OF THE SENSE OF CRISIS THAT HAD GRIPPED KOREA SINCE DECEMBER, WHEN THE COUNTRY DRIFTED TOWARD FINANCIAL COLLAPSE AND POLITICAL PARALYSIS. ON THE SURFACE, AT CONFIDENTIAL

LEAST, SIGNS ARE ENCOURAGING: THE CURRENCY HAS REGAINED

BEEN WELL IN THE BLACK FOR FOUR MONTHS RUNNING. THE ROKG

THOUGH PREOCCUPIED WITH DOMESTIC CONCERNS, PRESIDENT KIM HAS NONETHELESS OUTLINED AMBITIOUS FOREIGN POLICY INITIATIVES, INCLUDING LESS CONFRONTATION AND GREATER ECONOMIC COOPERATION WITH NORTH KOREA, RAPPROCHEMENT WITH JAPAN AND DIALOGUE WITH NORTHEAST ASIAN POWERS ON REGIONAL SECURITY.
- 5. (C) BENEATH THE SURFACE, HOWEVER, KOREA HAS JUST BEGUN TO REMEDY THE FUNDAMENTAL STRUCTURAL PROBLEMS THAT

BROUGHT ON THE "IMF CRISIS," AND MOST OF THE IMPROVED ECONOMIC SIGNS CAN BE TRACED TO THE MASSIVE INFUSION OF IMF-LED ASSISTANCE OR UNSUSTAINABLE BELT-TIGHTENING DRIVES BY BOTH INDUSTRY AND THE PUBLIC. AND WHILE KIM DAE-JUNG'S PERFORMANCE HAS SO FAR ECHOED THAT OF FRANKLIN ROOSEVELT -- REPLACING DRIFT WITH DECISIVE LEADERSHIP, CALMING PANIC, AND PROPOSING PROFOUND EVOLUTIONARY CHANGES TO SOLVE A NATIONAL CRISIS -- HE IS ALSO A LEADER WITHOUT A PARLIAMENTARY MAJORITY WHO COULD FACE SERIOUS DOMESTIC AND EXTERNAL CHALLENGES IN THE COMING MONTHS. (C) KIM HAS SO FAR URGED KOREANS TO EMBRACE THE FINANCIAL CRISIS AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE ESSENTIAL STRUCTURAL CHANGES IN THE WAY IT DOES BUSINESS, REMOVING BARRIERS TO THE FREE FLOW OF FOREIGN GOODS AND INVESTMENT, IMPLEMENTING MODERN LENDING AND ACCOUNTING PRACTICES, AND FORCING LABOR TO ACCEPT THE END OF LIFETIME JOB TENURE. HIS DETERMINATION WILL BE SORELY TESTED THIS YEAR AS THE ECONOMY LIKELY CONTRACTS BY AS MUCH AS THREE PERCENT, HEALTHY AND WEAK COMPANIES ALIKE GO INTO BANKRUPTCY, AND UNEMPLOYMENT SOARS TOWARD DOUBLE-DIGIT LEVELS. (C) PRESIDENT KIM WILL LOOK TO YOU FOR ASSURANCE OF STEADFAST U.S. SUPPORT FOR KOREA IN THIS CRISIS AND OF OUR FIRM BELIEF THAT IF HIS GOVERNMENT FULLY IMPLEMENTS ITS REFORM AGENDA, KOREA WILL EMERGE IN THE MEDIUM TERM AS A MUCH STRONGER, OPEN AND INTERNATIONALLY COMPETITIVE COUNTRY. IT WILL BE IMPORTANT TO NOTE AS WELL RISING PROTECTIONIST PRESSURES IN CONGRESS AND U.S. INDUSTRY IN THE FACE OF A LIKELY SURGE OF ASIAN EXPORTS. WE WILL NEED HELP FROM OUR ASIAN PARTNERS -- ESPECIALLY KOREA --IN DEMONSTRATING THAT OUR FOREIGN MARKET ACCESS CONCERNS ARE BEING ADDRESSED. 13. (C) SO MANY URGENT ISSUES DOMINATE OUR BILATERAL AGENDA THAT THE VITAL QUESTION OF WHERE THE RELATIONSHIP MIGHT GO AFTER THE NORTH-SOUTH CONFRONTATION IS RESOLVED OFTEN GETS SHORT SHRIFT. PRESIDENT KIM IS ONE OF THE FEW CONFIDENTIAL

14. (C) YOU WILL COME HERE DIRECTLY FROM BEIJING, A FEW DAYS AFTER THE VISIT TO SEOUL BY PRC VICE PRESIDENT HU JINTAO. THIS COINCIDENCE OFFERS AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY FOR YOU TO COMPARE NOTES ON CHINA'S APPROACH TO KOREAN ISSUES, THE ROLE EACH OF US ENVISAGES IT PLAYING ON THE PENINSULAR AFFAIRS, AND HOW BOTH OF US CAN ENCOURAGE CHINA'S MATURATION INTO A RESPONSIBLE MAJOR PLAYER IN REGIONAL AND GLOBAL AFFAIRS. OF COURSE, A CLOSE JAPANESE-KOREAN RELATIONSHIP IS ALSO IMPORTANT TO REGIONAL SECURITY. THE NEW ADMINISTRATION HAS PLEDGED TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO THE IMPORT OF JAPANESE GOODS AND CULTURE, TO NEGOTIATE A NEW FISHERIES AGREEMENT, AND TO SEEK A FINAL RESOLUTION OF COLONIAL-ERA WRONGS, SUCH AS THE MISTREATMENT OF "COMFORT WOMEN." WE SHOULD WELCOME PRESIDENT KIM'S EFFORTS TO MOVE PAST THESE LONG-STANDING DISAGREEMENTS.

(C) GIVEN KIM DAE-JUNG'S DEEP COMMITMENT TO HUMAN RIGHTS, WE MAY FIND THE NEW GOVERNMENT MORE WILLING TO WORK WITH US ON SUCH ISSUES AS BURMA, CAMBODIA, IRAN, AFGHANISTAN AND CUBA, ON WHICH IT TRADITIONALLY HAS KEPT A LOW PROFILE IN ORDER TO BOOST TRADE AND WOO THE DPRK'S THIRD WORLD SUPPORTERS. YOU MIGHT NOTE THAT THE ROK'S SIGNIFICANT TRADE TIES WITH COUNTRIES LIKE LIBYA AND IRAN GIVE IT LEVERAGE THAT SHOULD BE USED TO PRESS THOSE COUNTRIES TO ABANDON THEIR SUPPORT FOR TERRORISM AND OPPOSITION TO THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS.

16. (C) ON OTHER GLOBAL ISSUES, WE SHARE SIMILAR VIEWS ON THE NEED FOR LANDMINES ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA AS LONG AS NORTH KOREA POSES A THREAT OF INVASION. BUT WE ARE AT ODDS OVER UN SYSTEM REFORM: THE ROKG ARGUES THAT MIDSIZED COUNTRIES NEED A STRONGER VOICE IN UN AFFAIRS, AND HENCE THAT THE SECURITY COUNCIL SHOULD BE EXPANDED TO 25 OR 26 SEATS.
