REGOGNIZING THAT THE AIM OF THE UNITED NATIONS IN THE L FIELD OF DISARMAMENT IS AN EFFECTIVE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON THE PROHIBITION OF ATOMIC, HYDROGEN AND OTHER WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION WHICH WILL PROVIDE FOR THE CESSATION OF THE PRODUCTION OF SUCH WEAPONS, THE DESTRUCTION OF EXISTING STOCKS AND THE PROGRESSIVE LIMITATION OF CONVENTIONAL ARMAMENTS,

- RECOGNIZING FURTHER THAT THE DANGER NOW EXISTS THAT AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF STATES POSSESSING NUCLEAR WEAPONS MAY OCCUR AGGRAVATING INTERNATIONAL TENSION AND THE DIFFICULTY OF MAINTAINING WORLD PEACE AND THUS RENDERING MORE DIFFICULT THE ATTAINMENT OF THE GENERAL DISARMAMENT AGREEMENT ENVISAGED IN PARAGRAPH 1,
