

SUBJECT WAS TOLD THAT

WHEN INTERROGATORS ASKED ABOUT PEOPLE, THEY THEN WENT OUT TO FIND THEM; INTERROGATORS PROMISED SUBJECT THAT IT WAS IN HIS FRIENDS' BEST INTEREST FOR INTERROGATORS TO LOCATE THESE PEOPLE, AS THERE WAS NO TELLING WHAT OTHER U.S. AUTHORITIES MIGHT DO TO THEM IF THEY FOUND THEM FIRST.

14. INTERROGATORS TOLD SUBJECT THAT HE WAS GOING BACK INTO THE BIG BOX, AND THAT THEY WERE GOING TO TALK AGAIN ABOUT WALID AND OTHER THINGS. SUBJECT WAS TOLD THAT HE SUFFERED UNNECESSARILY TODAY BECAUSE HE DIDN'T PROVIDE COMPLETE RESPONSES UP FRONT; HE WAS WARNED TO THINK CAREFULLY AND NOT HOLD BACK ANYTHING WHEN THEY BEGAN AGAIN. CUBJECT WAS ALSO TOLD THAT INTERROGATORS HAD RELAYED HIS INFORMATION (b)(3) NatSecAct AND THAT INTERROGATORS HAD BEEN TOLD THAT THEY SAID THEY'D TALK MORE ABOUT THIS TOPIC WITH SUBJECT IS LYING. SUBJECT, AND THAT HE HAD BETTER BE THINKING OF FULL, COMPLETE AND

> HONEST ANSWERS TO PROVIDE THEM. SUBJECT WAS ALSO WARNED TO DRINK MORE OF HIS WATER, AND WAS THEN LOCKED IN HIS BOX AT 1700 HOURS.
