- 1. ASST SEC HABIB MET DECEMBER 9 WITH PRESIDENT PARK TO BRIEF HIM ON RESULTS OF PRESIDENT RWEM FORD'S VISIT TO EAST ASIA. AMBASSADOR, FOREIGN MINISTER, PRESIDENTIAL SECRETARY GENERAL AND INTERPRETER WERE ALSO PRESENT.
- HABIB BRIEFED PARK ON RESULTS OF PRESIDENT'S TRIP IN CONTEXT BROAD US ASIAN STRATEGY, POINTING OUT USG DESIRE KEEP PRESIDENT PARK INFORMED, ESPECIALLY WITH RESPECT RELATIONS WITH PRC. HABIB BRIEFING WAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERAL OUTLINE APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY.
