AND XALBAL, EL QUICHE

1. C - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. SUMMARY: AN EMBASSY TEAM VISITED THE DEPARTMENT OF EL QUICHE ON APRIL 19. EMBASSY USED THIS OPPORTUNITY TO INVESTIGATE THE VILLAGE CO-OPERATIVES OF SAN JUAN IXCAN AND KALBAL. EMBASSY UNDERSTANDS THAT THE AMERICAS WATCH COMMITTEE RECENTLY EXPRESSED AN INTEREST IN THESE VILLAGES, AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHERS. SAN JUAN IXCAN AND KALBAL ARE BOTH DESERTED AND BOTH LOCATED IN THE MO-MAN'S LAND OF MORTHERN EL QUICHE. ON APRIL 17. SEVERAL FORMER VILLAGERS OF SAN JUAN EXCAN TURNED THEMSELVES IN TO THE ARMY: THEY TOLD EMBASSY TEAM OF THEIR VILLAGE'S SACR BY GUERRILLAS, OF A FULL YEAR OF RUNNING IN THE MOUNTAINS, AND FINALLY, OF STARVATION, DESPERATION AND EXASPERATION WITH GUERRILLAS MIO ATE MILE THEY WENT HUNGRY. XALBAL IS SMALL, ISOLATED, DESTROYED AND DESERTED. ARMY OFFICERS TOLD MISSION MEMBERS THAT MALBAL WAS TAKEN BY GUERRILLAS SOMETIME IN LATE SPRING 1982, AND THAT THE VILLAGERS WERE FORCED INTO THE HOUNTAINS BY GUERRILLAS. THERE IS NO INDEPENDENT VERIFICATION OF THIS LATTER ACCOUNT. END SUMMARY.

J. THE MISSION TEAM FIRST STOPPED IN PLAYA GRANDE, EL QUICNE, SITE OF MILITARY ZONE NO. 22 MEADMIRETERS. THE LOCAL COMMANDER WAS IMPORMED BY EMBOFF WHERE THE EMBASSY WISHED TO VISIT. AT THE MENTION OF SAM JUAN LYCAN, MISSION TEAM WAS TOLD THAT SEVERAL INHARITANTS OF THAT VILLAGE HAD RECENTLY THRIFTD THEMSLIVES IN TO THE ARMY. THE VILLAGERS WERE OFBRIFFFED BY THE EMBASSY VISITORS. THEY RELATED THE

THE VILLAGERS DID NOT BELIEVE THIS AND THE MATOR SENT A MESSAGE TO THE ARMY REQUESTING PROTECTION THE GUERRILLAS RETURNED AND SEARCHED FOR THE MAYOR; THEY TOLD THE VILLAGERS HE WAS TO BE SHOT FOR BETRAVING THEM. THE INHABITANTS ASKED WHY ALL THIS WAS HAPPEHING; THE GUERRILLAS TOLD THEM THEY WERE NOW UNDER TREVOLUTIONARY LAW. T THE MATOR RAW AWAY; THE ARMY NEVER CAME. ON MARCH 1, 1982, THE GUERRILLAS FORCED THE ENTIRE VILLAGE INTO THE MOUNTAINS. THE VILLAGERS HAD NO CHOICE AND EVENTUALLY CAME TO BELIEVE THAT THE ARRY MIGHT INDEED HILL THEN AS THEY WERE HOW "GUERRILLAS." FOR A YEAR THE VILLAGERS RAN IN THE MOUNTAINS WITH THE GUERRILLAS. FOOD WAS SECONING MARDER AND MARDER TO COME BY, ALTHOUGH THE GUERRILLAS KEPT THEMSELVES DECENTLY FED. MALMUTRITION BECAME A SERIOUS PROBLEM. FINALLY, SOME OF THE VILLAGERS DECIDED TO RUN TO THE ARMY. ONE SAID HE DID NOT CARE WHAT HAPPENED TO HIM; HE DID NOT CARE IF THE ARMY HILLED HIM. IT WAS BETTER, HE SAID, THAN STARVING TO DEATH IN THE MOUNTAINS. HE WALRED TO PLAYA GRANDE AND TURNED HIMSELF OVER TO THE ARMY. HE WAS NOT MILLED, BUT FED. THE CHILDREN HE CAME WITH ARE CLOSE TO BEATH FROM HUNGER. IT IS NOT LIKELY THAT THE ARMY WILL BE ABLE TO SAVE ALL OF THEM; SOME ARE ALMOST CERTAIN TO DIE IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. THE MEOVE ACCOUNT WAS GIVEN IN BETWEEN SORS, TEARS AND BITTER DEMUNCIATIONS OF GUERRILLA BEHAVIOR.



TO DEBRIEF THESE VILLAGERS. PERHAPS 100 FORTUNATE. REVERTHELESS, WE REJECT THE IDEA OF AN ARRANGED SHOW, AND THIS FOR SEVERAL REASONS. THE ARMY DID NOT HAVE ENOUGH TIME TO ARRANGE MUCH AN EXHIBITION: EMBOFF PICKED SAK JUAN EXCAN AND KALBAL AT THE EAST MOMENT (IN THE AIR ON THE WAY TO EL QUICHEL, HE COULD HAVE JUST AS EASILY PICKED SOME OTHER VIELAGES; ARMY OFFICERS IN PLAVA GRANDE MAVE NEVER BEEN UNWILLING TO ADMIT THAT THERE ARE DOZENS OF DESERTED VILLAGES IN THEIR AREA AND THAT THEY REALLY BO NOT HIOU WHERE ALL THE VILLAGERS ARE; THE SAN JUAN EXCAN VILLAGERS PRESENT IN PLAYA GRANDE WERE NOT PROFESSIONAL ACTORS AND ALL MISSION MEMBERS PRESENT ON APRIL 19 MAD CONFIDENCE IN THEIR ACCOUNTS. IN ARY CASE. THE MALMUTRITION AND BITTERNESS WERE ALL TOO REAL AND IMPOSSIBLE TO FAKE. END matt.

6. AFTER SPEAKING WITH THE VILLAGERS FROM SAN JUAN INCAN, EMBASSY TEAM AND LOCAL COMMANDER FLEW TO MALBAL AND SAN JUAN INCAN. MALBAL IS IN NO-MAN'S LAND. GUERRILLAS TOOK THE VILLAGE IN THE LATE SPRING OF 1982 AND FORCED THE INNABITANTS INTO THE HOUNTAINS. THE ARMY HAS SINCE TRIED TO RESUILD A FEW OF THE MOUSES FOR USE AS A SEMI-PERMANENT BASE OF OPERATIONS. THE GUERRILLAS ALWAYS DESTROY THEN AGAIN. ON APRIL 19, THE VILLAGE WAS COMPLETELY DESERTED EXCEPT FOR A HORSE IN A MEARRY FIELD AND A SMILL GRINNING FROM A SHATTERED WALL. GHERRILLAS STILL OFFRATE IN THE IMPLDIATE AREA; NALBAL HAD TO BE SCOUTED BY AIR BEFORE LANDING - AGAIN, THE ACCOUNT OF THE NAIBAL WILLAGERS BEING FORCED VERHAUMETROME HELD TON CAN CHIATMING BUT OINS MERIFIED EMBAGN ES RIPORTING HERE THE MORD OL LOCAL TAUR FORCE COMMANDER

QUATER 03095 82 OF 82 2023442 HOUNTAINS, ALTHOUGH FAR MORE FOOD THAN WEAPOHRY HAS BEEN CAPTURED BY THE SAN JUAN SOLDIERS. FOOD HAS TO BE DELIVERED BY MELICOPTER. WHEN SUPPLIES ARE LATE THE SOLDIERS LIVE ON ROOTS. LOCAL TASA FORCE COMMANDER TOLD MISSION TEAM THAT THESE SOLDIERS ARE INSTRUCTED TO SHOOT TO MILL ALL UNIFORMED GUERRILLAS AND THOSE IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING THAT ARE BEARING AND USING ARMS AGAINST THEM. NON-COMBATANTS ARE ROUNDED UP FOR RESETTLEMENT IN THEIR ORIGINAL VILLAGES, IF AT ALL POSSIBLE. EMBASSY OFFICERS WERE TOLD THAT THE GUERRILLAS HAD RECENTLY FORCED SOME 38 SAN JUAN INCAN FAMILIES ACROSS THE BORDER INTO MEXICO WITH THE IDEA OF FORCING THEM TO SPREAD HORROR STORIES ABOUT THE GUATEHALAR ARMY. THERE IS NO INDEPENDENT VERIFICATION OF THIS ACCOUNT, EXCEPT FOR THE GENERALLY MISERABLE TREATMENT THE SAN JUAN IXCAN VILLAGERS RECEIVED AT THE HANDS OF THE GUERRILLAS. AFTER VISITING SAN JUAN IXCAN THE MISSION TEAM RETURNED TO GUATEMALA CITY. CHAPIN

- 2. SUMMARY: AN EMBASSY TEAM VISITED THE DEPARTMENT OF EL QUICHE ON APRIL 19. EMBASSY USED THIS OPPORTUNITY TO INVESTIGATE THE VILLAGE CO-OPERATIVES OF SAN JUAN IXCAN AND XALBAL. ON APRIL 17, SEVERAL FORMER VILLAGERS OF SAN JUAN IXCAN TURNED THEMSELVES IN TO THE ARMY; THEY TOLD EMBASSY TEAM OF THEIR VILLAGE'S SACK BY GUERRILLAS, OF A FULL YEAR OF RUNNING IN THE MOUNTAINS, AND FINALLY OF STARVATION, DESPERATION AND EXASPERATION WITH GUERRILLAS WHO ATE WHILE THEY WENT HUNGRY. XALBAL IS SMALL, ISOLATED, DESTROYED AND DESERTED. ARMY OFFICERS TOLD MISSION MEMBERS THAT XALBAL WAS TAKEN BY GUERRILLAS SOMETIME IN LATE SPRING 1982. AND THAT THE VILLAGERS WERE FORCED INTO THE MOUNTAINS BY GUERRILLAS. THERE IS NO INDEPENDENT VERIFICATION OF THIS LATTER ACCOUNT. END SUMMARY.
- 3. THE MISSION TEAM FIRST STOPPED IN PLAYA GRANDE, EL QUICHE, SITE OF MILITARY ZONE NO 11 HEADQUARTERS. THE LOCAL COMMANDER WAS INFORMED BY EMBOFF WHERE THE EMBASSY WISHED TO VISIT. AT THE MENTION OF SAN JUAN IXCAN MISSION TEAM WAS TOLD THAT SEVERAL INHABITANTS OF THAT VILLAGE HAD RECENTLY TURNED PAGE 1 (continued)

THEMSELVES IN TO THE ARMY. THE VILLAGERS WERE DEBRIEFED BY THE EMBASSY VISITORS. THEY RELATED THE FOLLOWING FACTS.

4.EGP GUERRILLAS BEGAN TO [ILLEGIBLE] [ILLEGIBLE] THE VILLAGE IN EARLY 1982. THEY TOLD THE VILLAGERS THAT THE ARMY WOULD COME ONE DAY TO KILL THEM ALL. THE VILLAGERS DID NOT BELIEVE THIS AND THE MAYOR SENT A MESSAGE TO THE ARMY REQUESTING PROTECTION. THE GUERRILLAS RETURNED AND SEARCHED FOR THE MAYOR, THEY TOLD THE VILLAGERS HE WAS TO BE SHOT FOR BETRAYING THEM. GUERRILLAS TOOK THE VILLAGE IN THE LATE SPRING OF 1982 AND FORCED THE INHABITANTS INTO THE MOUNTAINS. THE ARMY HAS SINCE TRIED TO REBUILD A FEW OF THE HOUSES FOR USE AS A SEMI-PERMANENT BASE OF OPERATIONS. THE GUERRILLAS ALWAYS DESTROY THEM AGAIN. ON APRIL 19, THE VILLAGE WAS COMPLETELY DESERTED EXCEPT FOR A

7. SAN JUAN IXCAN IS NOW HELD BY THE ARMY. A COMPANY OF TROOPS [ILLEGIBLE] [ILLEGIBLE] THERE AND PATROLS THE IMMEDIATE AREA [ILLEGIBLE] [ILLEGIBLE] GUERRILLA CAMPS HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED IN THE [ILLEGIBLE] MOUNTAINS, ALTHOUGH FAR MORE FOOD THAN WEAPONRY HAS BEEN CAPTURED BY THE SAN JUAN SOLDIERS. FOOD HAS TO BE DELIVERED BY HELICOPTER. WHEN SUPPLIES ARE LATE THE SOLDIERS LIVE ON ROOTS. LOCAL TASK FORCE COMMANDER TOLD MISSION TEAM THAT THESE SOLDIERS ARE INSTRUCTED TO SHOOT TO KILL ALL UNIFORMED GUERRILLAS AND THOSE IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING THAT ARE BEARING AND USING ARMS AGAINGST THEM. NON-COMBATANTS ARE ROUNDED UP FOR RESETTLEMENT IN THEIR ORIGINAL VILLAGES, IF AT ALL POSSIBLE. EMBASSY OFFICERS WERE TOLD THAT THE GUERRILLAS HAD RECENTLY FORCED SOME 30 SAN JUAN IXCAN FAMILIES ACROSS THE BORDER INTO MEXICO WITH THE IDEA OF FORCING THEM TO SPREAD HORROR STORIES ABOUT THE GUATEMALAN ARMY. THERE IS NO INDEPENDENT VERIFICATION OF THIS ACCOUNT, EXCEPT THE GENERALLY MISERABLE TREATMENT THE SAN JUAN IXCAN VILLAGERS RECEIVED AT THE HANDS OF THE GUERRILLAS. AFTER VISITING SAN JUAN IXCAN THE MISSION TEAM RETURNED TO GUATEMALA CITY. **CHAPIN**



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
