I DISCUSSED THE KIM DAE JUNG DASE AT LENGTH WITH PRESIDENT MUN DOD HEAR DECEMBER 13, MAKING A STRONG PITCH FOR COMMUTATION IF THE SENTENCE AND DESCRIPING THE SEVERE CONSEQUENCES OF AN EXECUTION FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR SECURITY AND ECONOMIC RELATION-HIP. CHUN DID NOT SOFTEN HIS POSITION ON KIM. HE TOLD ME, TIME PECISION OF THE COURT MUST BE RESPECTED. IF THE COURT CONFIRMS THE DEATH SENTENCE THAT SENTENCE SHOULD BE CARRIED OUT." THIS IS THE MOST RESTRICTIVE STATEMENT HE HAS MADE YET ON THE SUBJECT, ON THE OTHER HAND, CHUN WENT DUT OF HIS WAY TO STRESS THE DEEP HISTORICAL DEBT DEED THE U.S. BY KOREA AND THE IMPORTANCE OF ECONUMIC AND SECURITY TIES. HE ALSO STRESSED HIS WILLINGNESS TO GIVE CAREFUL CONSIDERATION TO OUR ADVICE. DEFENSE MINISTER CHOD TOLD HE AFTERWARDS TO PAY PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THIS LAST SENTENCE OF CHUN'S REMARKS. I CANNOT STRIKE THE BALANCE BETHEEN THE DISCOURAGING AND ENCOURAGING COMMENTS. HIS REMARKS COULD MEAN ANY OF THREE THINGS:

--CONTRARY TO RECENT EVIDENCE THAT HE IS RETHINKING THED ISSUE AND SEEKING A HAY OF COMMUTING A SENTENCE HITHOUT LOSING FACE, CHUN HAS MADE UP HIS MIND TO EXECUTE KIM.

-- CHUN IS SETTING UP THE COURT TO TAKE THE HEAT BY DECIDING THAT KIM SHOULD BE RETRIED.

--CHUN IS POSTURING FOR HIS MILITARY AUDIENCE (WHO HAD WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE DEFENSE MINISTER LEFT THE ROOM, RECAUSE AT MY INITIATIVE THE SIZE OF THIS PART OF THE MEETING HAD BEEN REDUCED, BUT TO WHOM HE MAY HAVE PREPARED THIS FORMULATION OF HIS POSITION) MAKING CLEAR THAT HE WILL NOT MAKE CONCESSIONS TO FOREIGN VISITORS, IN AN EFFORT TO PLAY FOR MORE TIME.

FRANKLY, I DO NOT KNOW WHICH OF THE ABOVE IS CORRECT. THE ATMOSPHERE UP THE MEETING WAS EXCELLENT, WITH CHUN BEHAVING IN A CORDIAL, CONFIDENT AND EVEN AT TIMES DEFERENTIAL MANNER. I AM SURE OF THU THINGS, HOWEVER -- THAT THE COMBINATION OF YOUR LETTER AND MY PRESENTATION HAS LEFT NO DOURT OF THE STRENGTH OF AN AMERICAN REACTION SHOULD KIM BE EXECUTED, AND THAT WE HAVE MADE EVERY EFFORT POSSIBLE TO MAKE OUR POINT. WE HAVE TAKEN OUR BEST SHOT; I HOPE IT IS ENDUGH.
