## 6. Soviet Union

The Soviets' first solid propellent intercontinental ballistic missile—
the SS-13—probably will be operational
in about six months. There are indica—
tions that testing is entering an advanced stage, and satellite photography
shows that the first of the new single
silos being built for it will be complete by early 1969. Only 31 of the
new silos have been detected since construction began in mid-1967—a much
slower deployment rate than noted in
earlier Soviet intercontinental ballis—
tic missile programs.

## 7. Guyana

Burnham appears to have won a clear majority in Monday's election and now, for the first time, can govern without the millstone of a coalition. The public, caught up in the traditional holiday revelries, is unlikely to care much about the charges of rigging from the opposition.
