Chronology of TRR Conversion/Spent Fuel
Return Program

- 1977 B1
- U.S. and CCNA agree to investigate technical and economic feasibility of converting TRR core to LEU and removal of TRR spent fuel from Taiwan. TRR operation until 12/31/80. B1
- 1978, April 20, - U.S. meets with GOC to discuss TRR conversion and spent fuel removal; GOC agrees to pay for transportation costs associated with spent fuel return of 470 elements.
- 1979, May 2-4 - US/INER technical teams meet in Taiwan to discuss results of feasibility study; teams agree to continue to study the conversion problem.
- 1980, Jan - U.S. meets with INER in Taiwan.
- 1980, June ANL (Lewis) completes plan for converting TRR to 20% MTR fuel; SRL completes cost estimates for spent fuel return.
- 1980, Sept - U.S. meets with GOC to discuss U.S. conversion proposal and spent fuel return costs; GOC agrees to seek \$ for spent fuel return.
- 1980, Oct - US/INER technical experts meet to discuss conversion/SFR INER proposes oxide, partial conversion plan; denigrates ANL plan.
- 1982, June U.S. revisits Taiwan to discuss conversion/SFR: Memo of Understanding is first written indication of CCNA agreement and work plan for conversion/SFR.
- 1982, Sept - U.S. technical team revisits Taiwan to note progress on conversion and to offer assistance; SFR question not raised.
