New Zealand Embassies Accept Assistant Secretary Robertson proposed following plan on timing and method presenting introduction new weapons into Korea and May 16

1. No later July 1, 1957 Senior UNC Representative Military Armistice
Commission would make statement Panmunjom reviewing Communist violations paragraph 13(d) Armistice Agreement, explaining problem posed by practical impossibility replacing worn-out UNC equipment with 1953 items and pointing out result has been development military imbalance. In view Communist violations 13(d) QUOTE UNC considers that it is entitled be relieved of corresponding obligations under provisions this paragraph until such time as relative military balance has been restored and Communist side by its actions demonstrated willingness comply UNQUOTE. Statement would conclude with assurance UNC intends maintain Armistice, does not intend arms race and only purpose its action to restore relative military balance.
