EVENTS WHICH HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN SAMASHKI.

- -- THE EUROPEAN UNION UTTERLY CONDEMNS ATROCITIES AGAINST CIVILIANS IN VIOLATION OF BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS.
- -- ONCE AGAIN, IT EARNESTLY APPEALS TO THE RUSSIAN AUTHORITIES TO PUT AN END TO THE VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PEOPLE, TO CONCLUDE A CEASE-FIRE WITHOUT DELAY, TO START NEGOTIATIONS TO SOLVE THE CONFLICT BY POLITICAL, NOT MILITARY MEANS, AND TO ALLOW HUMANITARIAN AID TO BE SENT TO THE STRICKEN POPULATION WITHOUT HINDRANCE, IN KEEPING WITH INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN LAW.
- -- ONCE AGAIN, IT URGES THAT THE OSCE ASSISTANCE GROUP IN CHECHNYA BE SET UP QUICKLY SO THAT IT CAN HELP TO ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES.
