TEXT: 1. IN LATE MAY 1983, [Redacted] ONE OF THE ARGENTINE MILITARY SERVICES HAD DETAINED A PROMINENT MONTONERO NAMED ((HAYDAR)) (FNU) ON ABOUT 10 MAY. [Redacted] THE MILITARY SERVICE WAS ALMOST FINISHED INTERROGATING HAYDAR, AND IT WAS PLANNED TO HAVE HIM DIE IN SOME SORT OF MANUFACTURED PUBLIC INCIDENT. HOWEVER, [Redacted] THE MILITARY SERVICE BELIEVED THAT THERE WAS TOO MUCH CURRENT CONTROVERSY OVER OTHER MONTONEROS WHO HAD DIED IN SIMILAR INCIDENTS, AND IT WAS PLANNED TO WAIT A WEEK OR SO UNTIL THIS PUBLIC INTEREST HAD DIED DOWN BEFORE KILLING HAYDAR.

A. HAYDAR IS PROBABLY RENE RICARDD ((HAIDAR)), ALSO CALLED RICARDO RENE ((HAIDAR)), WHO WAS IDENTIFIED AS A PROMINENT MONTONERO IN 1977.
B. THE MILITARY SERVICE INVOLVED IS PROBABLY THE ARMY, WHICH WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR SEVERAL RECENT STAGED

[Redacted] AFTER HAYDAR WAS ARRESTED HE WAS ESCORTED BY ARGENTINE INTELLIGENCE OFFICERS TO MADRID AND GENEVA WHERE HE WITHDREW SOME 65 MILLION U.S. DOLLARS FROM BANK ACCOUNTS OF THE MONTONEROS.)
