Following letter from President should be conveyed PriMin Ben-Gurion:
"Dear Mr. Prime Minister:

"I thank you for your letter of May 27 concerning American visits to Israel's nuclear facility at Dimona. I know your words reflect your most intense personal consideration of a problem that is not easy for you or for your Government, as it is not for mine.

"I welcome your strong reaffirmation that the Dimons will be devoted exclusively to peaceful purposes. I also welcome your reaffirmation of Israel willingness to permit periodic visits to Dimona.

"Because of the crucial importance of this problem, however, I am of sure you will agree that such visits should be/a nature and on a schedule which will more nearly be in accord with international standards, thereby resolving all doubts as to the peaceful intent of the Dimona project. As I wrote you on 18 May, this Covernment's commitment to and support of Esrael could be seriously jeopardized if it should be thought that we amable to obtain reliable information on a subject as wital to eace a

"Therefore, I asked our scientists to review the alternative schedules of ts we and you have proposed. If Israel's purposes are to be clear to the d beyond reasonable doubt, I believe that the schedule which would best serve common purposes would be a visit early this summer, another visit in June 1964, thereafter at intervals of six months. I am sure that such a schedule should cause you any more difficulty than that which you have proposed. It would be ntial, and I take it that your letter is in accord with this, that our sciens have access to all areas of the Dimona site and to any related part of the lex, such as fuel fabrication facilities or plutonium separation plant, and sufficient time be allotted for a thorough examination.
