Proposal for a Project in the Field of Stimulants (Psychological)

Introduction: Same

Project: A Project for the evaluation of the psychological phenomena observed in human beings under stimulation.

Materials: Common stimulants in their pure and available forms- Specific materials to be agreed upon with the contractor.

Phases:

- 1) Effect of stimulation progressively upon
 - a) Coordination
 - b) Dexterity
 - c) Reasoning Power
 - d) Memory
 - e) Inhibition
- 2) Perception
- 3) Initiative
- 2) Determination of the character of hallucinations, if any, which result.
e.g.- Vision of colors
- 3) Relation of these hallucinations, if possible, to past experience of the subject.
- 4) Determination of the psychological phenomena observable which would be valid warnings of an approaching condition of coma or death.
