Research Project

- 1. ADSI has requested concurrence in a proposed external research project to be conducted under his general direction in connection with his research under Project AdTIGAUNG.
- 2. The proposed project concerns the application of so-called "side tone delay" to interrogation techniques. It is utilized in connection with obtaining information from subjects who have given "positive" guilt responses under polygraph examination. The effect upon a subject of application of side tone delay is to delay, for a fraction of a second, speech of the individual travelling to his own ears. Apparently the effect of such delay upon the subject leads him to the independent conclusion that his speech difficult; has made his cuilt obvious to the examiner. His association of guilt with his lick of speech central is similar to the manifestations of guilt of an inexpert liar (stuttering, stammering, confusion, etc.).
- 3. It is possible that recitive development and findings in this field will be of value to particularly in connection with interrogation of individuals for purposes of ascertaining their bone fides.
