SUBJECT: Conversations with [REDACTED] in Washington - 12-September 1951

1. [REDACTED] agreed a full time literature surveyor might well be used. He suggested use of a graduate student who wished to earn money for a year before continuing his studies. [REDACTED] hoped that [REDACTED] would have some names to suggest.
