




b. In the course of a detailed discussion of the physiological effects in which we are interested, the following points were made:

c. Dimethyl mercury ( $Hg(Et)_2$ ) - produces a delayed mental confusion. Delays is often as long as two weeks. Further details in Clark's "Therapeutics" p. 33.

d. Alpha, alpha diphenyl succinimide.



\_\_\_\_\_ found that this compound produces a delayed paralysis. A dose of 50-60 mg/Kg, given as a single dose gives paralysis in usually 10 days. It is more effective in more highly developed animals. \_\_\_\_\_ thinks more active compounds could be discovered with further investigation.
