#### LEMCRANDUM FOR THE RECCRD

SUBJECT: International Connections of the United States
Peace Movement

- I. CLA is to prepare an independent study on the International Connections of the United States Peace Movement. This Study, which was requested by the President, is to include information from all sources. It will include the names of all individuals in the United States Peace Movement who have connections of any kind with Soviets, Communists, or any foreign persons or organisations.
- 2. On 31 October 1967, Chief, CI Stall laid down the requirements and responsibilities of the Claudestine Services in contributing to this Study. Present at the meeting were Chief, CI Stall; Chief CI/Ci., Deputy Chief, CI Stall; Chief CI/Ci., Deputy Chief CI/Ci., Richard Cher, CI
- 3. The DEI will be responsible for writing the Study. The CI Stall will be responsible for pulling together all information available in the Claudestine Services and presenting it to the DDL. CI Stall will be responsible for obtaining all information available to the Cifice of Security. CI Stall will also be responsible for obtaining through its idaison channels all pertinent information from other Agencies including FBI, Immigration of Naturalization Service, Secret Service, Deisman Department, Army, Navy, and Air Force, etc. It is assumed that OCI will handle contacts with NSA on this Subject. Cher is to bring to the attention of the DDI the NSA report titled "Associations Between U.S. Peace Movement and Foreign Communist Communistions." (Report dated 22 October 1967). The following have been identified to the DDI as persons in the Claudestine Services who will be involved in this effort:
