(Washington Peace Center)

In compliance with Subject memo dated 24 February 1967, the enclosed reports are submitted concerning a Quaker group, "Friends", that met at WPC on 26 February 1967.

This group demonstrated strictly religious motivations during this gathering and [REDACTED] heard nothing of a political or militant nature; nor did he see any indication that other organizations or groups were meeting at the WPC.

[REDACTED] has been directed to spot check the WPC and any time he sees the gates unlocked or open, to go in and determine who and what is taking place. Should he find there are other groups than "Friends" meeting there, a course of action will be planned to penetrate the group.

Request advice as to whether further action should be taken in regards to "Friends".
