## MEMORANDUM FOR:

SUBJECT: Demonstrations in Washington, D.C. 7 - 8 May 1967

- 1. The FBI has advised that the "Victnem Draft Hearings Committee, 307 Eastern Parkway, Brooklyn, New York, has issued a flyer stating it intends to demonstrate in Washington, D.C. on May 7 and 6 during Congressional hearings on the Selective Service Act. The address listed by the group is the address of Rick Rhoades, an official of the Peking-line Progressive Labor Party.
- 2. The Washington Ad Hec Vietnam Draft Hearings Committee, Greenbelt, Maryland, a recently formed group, also has indicated it will hold demonstrations for the same reason on the indicated days. The group plans on having 1,000 to 3,000 persons participating in rallies and workshops in Lafayette Park on the 7th and a march on the Capital on the 8th. They also plan to picket the Unite House on the afternoon of the 8th. (This, of course, is the week before the Delinger-now in Stockholm for the "war crimes tribunal"-plans his march on D.C.)
