1. On 11 October 1967, an emergency meeting of the National Mobilization Committee to End the War in Vietnam took place at the offices of the Woman's Strike for Peace, 2140 P Street, NW, Washington, D. C. This meeting was convened in preparation of the demonstration conducted in Washington, D. C., the weekend of 21 October 1967.

2. It was determined that a vehicle registered to the above Subject was parked in close proximity to the WSP offices. [REDACTED]

3. Attempts are being made to determine whether or not a relationship exists between the Subject and the alluded to meeting. The information contained herein was obtained through a surveillance. A picture of the Subject was shown to a source who advised that she looks familiar but that he cannot categorically state he saw Subject at the WSP offices.

4. Another individual who is familiar with the internal activities of the WSP was asked whether she knew of anyone bearing the name of the Subject. This source advised that the name sounds "very familiar" but cannot recall where she first heard the name. This source will be shown the Subject's photograph for further identification.
