We were very cordially received and were served coffee soon after sitting down. Extending explained in very precise words that the Bureau was vitally interested in Subject because of her reporting and the stature she had gained in WSP. He emphasized that he in particular was very interested in the "Peace Movement" and was desperately seeking good sources of information. The meeting lasted over an hour and a half and proved to be productive in many ways. It is believed the spectrum was covered without leaving anything unanswered and it ended with the stipulation that she was willing and happy to work with and the Bureau providing "that my activity will in no way prejudice or hamper work or association with what he has done in the past. She further said that ification was cut out and no longer used in the Project, she too would bow out and quit her activity. She asked the question, "Do I understand that if I do not work for you was then I do not work for anyone else?" To which the replied, "That is my understanding. The writer said nothing to this. However, when she asked me if I objected to her working with the Bureau, I told her I thought it was the proper thing to do because it was their delegated responsibility and they would be able to better target and direct her and anything she reported would be disseminated to interested authorities. At the end, she asked that she be given assurance that we would not be affected, and if she were given this assurance, then she would call was for further guidance and instructions.
