With reference to the attached Washington Post clipping of 14 June 1963, "World Plot Sets Off Campus Revolts", it may be of interest to note that the Axel SPRINGER whose newspaper building in Berlin was the target of Left-Wing German student riots in April 1967, following an assassination attempt against student leader Rudi DUTSCHEE, has been of interest to this agency in the past.

2. The attack on Axel SFRINGER publications, which triggered a chain reaction among students all over the world, has been widely interpreted as Pro-Communist largely because of the fact that he is considered so vigorously Anti-Communist.


